Learn how to do turned applique with the back-basting method in this one-day workshop creating an 8" X 8" quilt block.

Fabric Kit is provided with the registration fee. (Includes background and applique fabrics for the 8" X 8" quilt block)

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine, power cord, foot pedal
- Karen Kay Buckley scissors, or scissors labeled for applique work will be ok too.
- Size 10 or 11 Straw Needles, (also known as Milliner's needles)
- Sewing supplies: seam ripper, pins, bobbins, clips & thread

❖ **Historical note** – Straw needles also commonly known as milliner's needles, are extra-long hand-sewing needles with a sharp point, a small round eye, and a uniform shaft. They get their name "straw" because they were historically used in traditional straw-hat making.

- The Retreat House provides two ironing stations. You may bring a small portable iron and ironing mat if you prefer.
