



Wild Onion Quilt Workshop

The swirling blocks in blue onion are made from a variety of contrasting prints. The arcs are long and gentle which makes them easy to sew.

Fabric Requirements:

- 3/8 yard of 6 different dark/medium value fabrics
- 3/8 yard of 6 different light/medium value fabrics
- **Or** 12 different contrasting prints

Fabric Recommendations:

- Fat quarters are not appropriate for this pattern.

Required Supplies:

- Blue Onion Pattern
- Oval All Ways Ruler by Creative Grids (2 available for rental through the Textile Studio)
- Sewing Machine with 1/4" foot
- Rotary cutter with a new blade (28 mm or 45 mm)
- Neutral thread
- Basic sewing supplies (pins, seam ripper, etc.)

Optional Supplies:

- 18" X 24" cutting mat

General Information:

- A 10% discount will be provided for any products or other supplies purchased on the day of the workshop.
- A lunch break will be provided, bring your own lunch or plan on ordering from one of the local restaurants.
- The Retreat House provides two ironing and two cutting stations.
