

LAYERED SUEDE EARRINGS



SUPPLIES:


- Husqvarna Viking® sewing machine
- Non-Stick Glide Foot H (Item #412796145)
- Faux Suede (Item #920533096 OR #920534096)
We used Blue from Collection D #920534096
Note: Faux Leather (Item #920531096 or #920532096) may be substituted for the Faux Suede
- Rayon embroidery thread
- Fishhook style earring wires
- Template for earrings
- Fabric marking pen
- Sewing awl or eyelet punch

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut out the templates for the earrings.
2. Using the fabric marking pen, trace the templates onto the right side of the suede. Do NOT cut out the earrings until after stitching.
3. Snap on the Non-Stick Foot.
4. Set the machine for a straight stitch.
5. Start stitching at the top inside edge of each piece (where the dots are located on the templates).
6. Stitch from point to the outer edge with a curved line, turn fabric and stitch on the same curved line back to the beginning point – do NOT cut thread.

- Repeat this step for three more lines of stitching, ending at the beginning point. (Smaller pieces will only have three rows of stitching.)
7. All four pieces of suede will be stitched in this way.
 8. Cut out the four pieces on the traced outlines being careful not to cut into the stitching.
 9. Cut slits between the rows of curved lines again being careful not to cut into the stitching.
 10. Make a small hole in the top of each piece with the awl or eyelet punch.
 11. Layer one smaller and one larger piece onto each of the fishhook wires with the smaller piece in the front.
