

TEXTURED LEATHER EARRINGS



SUPPLIES:


- Husqvarna Viking® sewing machine
- Non-Stick Glide Foot H (Item #412796145)
- Faux Leather (Item #920531096 or #920532096)
We used Cream from Collection B #920532096
Note: Faux Suede (Item #920533096 OR #920534096) may be substituted for the Faux Leather
- Rayon embroidery thread
- Fishhook style earring wires
- Template for earrings
- Fabric marking pen
- Sewing awl or eyelet punch
- Fabric glue

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut out the templates for the earrings.
2. Using the fabric marking pen, trace the templates onto the right side of the leather. Do NOT cut out the earrings until after stitching.
3. Snap on the Non-Stick Foot.
4. Select the decorative stitches of your choice.
(We used stitches G: 28, 4.0 width and 7.0 length for the vertical stitches and C: 7, 3.0 width and 2.5 length for the horizontal stitches on the Husqvarna Viking® Designer Brilliance™ 80 sewing machine.)
5. Sew consecutive vertical rows of decorative stitching. Then sew consecutive rows of horizontal stitching.

6. Apply glue to the back of the fabric – be certain to go beyond the stitches.
This will prevent threads from raveling.
7. Apply another layer of leather (approximately 4" width x 3" height to the back side, wrong sides together. Let glue dry completely.
8. Cut out the earrings on the traced markings.
Note: If any thread ravel after cutting, add a very small amount of glue on the edges.
9. Make a small hole in the top of each piece with the awl or eyelet punch.
10. Slide each piece onto a fishhook wire.
