- 2. Exhibits to be sold will have a "For Sale" tag attached. There will be a 10% commission on items sold at the show.
- 3. Every item entered must have a completed entry form attached.
- 4. Quilts must have a <u>covered</u> label listing quilt name, owner's name, address and telephone number.
- 5. Quilts must be entered at the Creek County Fairgrounds, on **Tuesday**, **November 2ND**, **2021**, **3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. or Wednesday**, **November 3RD**, **2021**, **9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** The fairgrounds are located 4 ½ miles west of Sapulpa on Highway 66.
- 6. Quilts are judged Thursday, November 4th, 9:00 a.m. 5:00 p.m.
- 7. Quilts are on display to the public November 5^{th} , 9:00 5:00 and November 6^{th} 9:00 4:00.
- 8. Quilts may be picked up November 6th from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 pm at the Creek County Fairgrounds, or the following Monday at the OSU Extension Office at the fairgrounds. They will not be dismissed before that time.
- 9. The doors to the show will be locked from 4:00 p.m. 5:00 p.m., November 6th to prepare quilts for dismissal.
