Criteria for Entry in Creek County OHCE Quilt Show:

1. NO quilt that has previously judged in Creek County OHCE sponsored quilt show may be entered for judging a second time.
2. Exhibits to be sold will have a "For Sale" tag attached. There will be a 10% commission on items sold at the show.
3. **Every item entered must have a completed entry form attached.**
4. Quilts must have a covered label listing quilt name, owner's name, address and telephone number.
5. Quilts must be entered at the Creek County Fairgrounds, on **Tuesday, November 2ND, 2021, 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. or Wednesday, November 3RD, 2021, 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** The fairgrounds are located 4 ½ miles west of Sapulpa on Highway 66.
6. Quilts are judged Thursday, November 4th, 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
7. Quilts are on display to the public November 5th, 9:00 – 5:00 and November 6th 9:00 – 4:00.
8. **Quilts may be picked up November 6th from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 pm** at the Creek County Fairgrounds, or the following Monday at the OSU Extension Office at the fairgrounds. **They will not be dismissed before that time.**
9. The doors to the show will be locked from 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m., November 6th to prepare quilts for dismissal.
