Garden City Fire Restriction


Due to current and forecasted weather conditions, coupled with the extremely dry conditions in Garden City, Utah, the Garden City Town Council has determined that measures must be taken to prevent the ignition of fires. Therefore, the Garden City Town Council has prohibited the following acts as described below:

1. Setting, building, maintaining, attending or using fires of any kind, except within the facilities designated for them in improved campgrounds, picnic areas or home sites where running water is present.
2. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle, trailer or building, a developed recreation site or while stopped in an area that is paved or free from dry vegetation.
3. Discharging or using any kind of fireworks, tracer ammunition or other pyrotechnic devices including exploding targets.

The above acts are prohibited within the Garden City municipal town limits and noncompliance can result in a citation of \$500 and confiscation of items.

The Utah State Forester's office has banned fireworks in all unincorporated private and all state lands within Rich County.
