Snow Fern Mittens work up quickly with Heavy—Worsted or Aran weight yarn. Worked in the round with a gusseted thumb. A large cable is featured in the center of the mitten that slowly tapers outwards and inwards, creating a fern—like shape. A longtail tubular cast—on is utilized, allowing these mittens to fit a wider range of hand sizes. Written in one size. All repeats appear in bold text throughout pattern for easier reading. This pattern is charted and also includes separate written instructions. There is a matching hat pattern.



Materials: BERROCO LANAS LIGHT (100 grs): 1 hank each #78101 Fog (C1) and #78110 Grapefruit (C2) -You

will have enough for the hat too! Needles/Notions: 16" / 40 cm circular needle, size 5 / 3.75 mm or size to obtain gauge & 16" / 40 cm circular needle, size 3 / 3.25 mm, if using Tubular Cast-On; Stitch markers, 1 a different color for BOR. Cable needle (optional)



If you know the basic crochet stitches, and would like to use them in a creative way,

the Advanced Beginner Crochet class will help you take your

crocheting to the next step. The class will cover a variety of stitches, including the popcorn stitch, puff stitch, and shell stitch. It will also cover working between stitches, working under one loop, and working around the post of the stitch.

You must know how to make the chain, the single crochet, and the double crochet stitches. Please purchase a medium weight yarn that is a medium color. Encore is a good yarn for practice. Don't use a variegated or textured yarn. Bring a size H or I crochet hook, or both.




Sock Club Every Tuesday, 10 - 11 a.m.

Learn to knit a basic fair isle hat. You will choose your own motifs and color combinations. Please bring a 16" circular needle size US 7 for a hat or a 24" circular size US 7 for a cowl. Homework: Cast on 100 stitches on a 16" circular needle

# Comet Trails Scarf Class (Fission Knitting) with Darlene

(Knit in person)

Fridays, January 19 & 26, 2 - 4 p.m. Fee: \$60/2 weeks

The **Comet Trails Scarf S** features 2 different cable motifs of two colours on each side of the fabric!

Fission Knitting is a reversible knitting technique where two yarns are worked in a marl. It



creates a super squishy fabric with different raised colorwork cables on each side of the fabric. This motif is designed so you will practice each Fission Knitting stitch before moving onto the next. But you won't have to wait – you will see the reversible magic start to happen within the first few rows!

This is a great project for advanced knitters looking to learn the Fission Knitting technique.

The Sea Garden Cowl is inspired by the beauty of the undersea world's gentle movement of marine plants with the tide. Created with 18 crocheted squares, each



bearing a floral center using popcorn stitch, the cowl's petal shapes yield a three-dimensional texture reminiscent of a serene underwater garden. You will 3 contrasting colors of The Fibre Co's Cirro & a size US 1 crochet hook. Yarn must be purchased at MYS

## Weaving (In Person)

**Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving:** 

Getting to Know Your Loom with Georg Luxton

Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already), warp it and do a balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your loom



together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg.

Rigid Heddle Warping: Tips & Tricks with Georg

Join this zoom class on WARPING the Rigid Heddle Loom if you want to review how to figure out how much yarn you need for a project and how to figure out which heddle to use. You will also learn how to warp a LONG length on the rigid heddle. Bring your loom!

Sunday, January 14 2 - 4 p.m.

Warp Weft Poncho with Georg Luxton Learn how to weave a PATTERN on the rigid heddle loom using pick up sticks. You'll need at least 2 pick up sticks to create WARP/WEFT FLOATS that will turn plain weave into an overall textured pattern. Weave 2 pieces that can be turned into a poncho.
