Beginning Knitting



Correcting Mistakes (knit) with Darlene Joyce

Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle? Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will learn to pick up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of the row. The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. (Syncopated Brioche) Gather a colorful selection of DK weight varns for this twocolor brioche cowl knit in the round. When you're ready for something new, the ribbed columns syncopate so the knits are purled and the purls are knit. The large circumference wraps easily around the neck for extra warmth. Designed by Stephen West. Experience with brioche helpful.

One Sock *Slowly* (The Fibre Co.) (hybrid class) with Darlene & Nick

This class will move at a slow pace so we can get to every detail & share multiple ways to knit your sock. "Slow and steady wins the race".

Week One: Cuff Week Two: Leg Week Three: Heel Week Four: Gusset Week Five: Toe



One Sock is a classic top-down sock pattern to fit all feet, designed in sock varn Amble. With lots of opportunities to customize the fit and design, this pattern comes with the One Sock Guidebook, a resource that walks makers through the process of knitting beautiful socks that fit.

Choose one full skein of Amble and one or two mini skeins depending desired style (stripes, contrasting heel/toe, etc.) Size 2.5 mm needle for preferred method of knitting a small circumference.

We would prefer that all students have some experience working in the round on a small circumference.

Forest Breeze Tee (Easy V-Neck Top)

Trellis Cardigan

Wednesdays, 3-4 p.m. August 3 to 17 Fee:\$50 (Zoom class)

An open front crocheted cardigan that can be dressed up or down with a stitch pattern that mimics cables and lace. Cardigan is worked from the right sleeve cuff, across the body, to the left sleeve cuff. Side and sleeve seams are sewn and then edgings are worked along the sleeve cuffs, hem, front, and neck edges.





Jacintha (\$60) Tuesdays, July 12 to 26 6:30-8 p.m. (knit via Zoom)

From Noro's new Spring/Summer 2022 magazine, Geshi in chevron stitch makes the a perfect top! Although the top only comes in one size, it is meant to boxy and loose. If you

need a smaller or larger size, you may need to reduce/increase the number of stitches or knit at a different gauge. You will need 2 skeins of Geshi and size US 5 & 6 needle.

Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving:

Getting to Know Your Loom with Georg Luxton



Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already), warp it and do a balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your

loom together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg.
