#### Bramwell

(knit in person) with June Sorensen

Tuesdays, July 15, 22, August 5 & 12, 2 - 4 pm. Fee: \$120/4 weeks

Bramwell is a top-down triangular shawl featuring two traditional leaf lace patterns. Many leaf lace patterns are

composed of simple stitches and shorter pattern repeats, which make them perfect for newer lace knitters. But even experienced lace knitters will enjoy it. The Bramwell pattern includes both charts and full written out. Instructions for those of you who prefer not to use charts.

Bramwell would be an excellent project for a "first lace" shawl, as the pattern is filled with detailed explanations, helpful hints and includes lots of video links that show all the stitches and techniques required to knit the shawl.



# **Knit Classes**

**Correcting Mistakes** with Darlene Joyce Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle? Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will



learn to pick up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of the row. The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. Please pick up homework sheet or find on our website.

**Brioche Starter Cowl** with Darlene This pretty cowl is fun to knit and quick to make! It's knit in the round, which is easy to do in brioche. As its name implies, it's a good beginner's cowl or a good refresher. Pattern is \$5.99. Designed by Cynthia Spencer.

#### **Intro to Fair Isle Knitting** with Darlene Joyce (in person class)

Learn to knit a basic fair isle hat. You will choose your own motifs and color combinations. Please bring a 16" circular needle size US 7 for a hat or a 24" circular size US 7 for a cowl. Homework: Cast on 100 stitches on a 16" circular needle size US 5, join in the round and



work in ribbing for 1 1/4". (If you are choosing to make a cowl, cast on 140 stitches on a circular needle US 5).

#### **Tailfeather**

Wednesday, July 23 & 30 5 - 7 p.m. Fee: \$80/2 weeks

Wrap yourself in a big, beautiful scarf and show off your plumage. Tailfeather is a unisex lace scarf with long interlocking feather motifs.



The garter-based lace pattern is fast and easy to knit, and looks great on both sides. Two width options are given. Materials: 470 to 610 yards of dk/worsted weight yarn, size US 7 needle & pattern.

#### **Abbreviated Shortie Socks**

Wednesday, August 13 to 27 5 - 7 p.m. Fee: \$120/3 weeks

Perky little thick socks for worsted

weight yarn. Striped sock pattern for adults/teens. Seamless styled toes and heels. Quick and easy little accessory. A fun and useful way to use up small bits of yarn. Suggested Yarn: HiKoo Simplicity (3 skeins, one in each color)

# Beginner Crochet: Next Steps

#### How to Crochet a Ball Friday, July 18, 11 am -1 pm

You will start with a magic ring and learn to increase. In the next class you will learn how to decrease and finish you ball. Georg will go over pattern reading. Learning to crochet a ball is the stepping stone to all other crocheted toys (amigurumi).

How to Crochet a Granny Square Saturday, July 5, 10 am - 12 pm Saturday, August 2, 3 - 5 pm



Learn to make a basic granny square that you can use as a coaster. You will need a "G" hook & 3 skeins of <u>Coastal Cotton</u> in contrasting colors.

# How to Crochet a Granny Stitch Scarf Saturday, August 2,

Learn how to crochet a granny stitch (not square) scarf. Darlene will demo the foundation single crochet for those students who



want to try it. You will need one skein of Cumulus or Cumulus Dappled and a size 5.5 mm crochet hook.

If you know the basic crochet stitches, and would like to use them in a creative way. This cllass will help you take your crocheting to the next step. The class covers a variety of stitches, including the popcorn stitch, puff stitch, and shell stitch. It will also cover working between stitches, working under one loop, and working around the post of the stitch.

You must know how to make the chain, the single crochet, and the double crochet stitches. Please purchase a medium weight yarn like Encore Worsted or Vintage that is a medium color. Bring whatever

# Hello Spring Ponchette

Designed for one skein of fingering weight yarn, this ponchette is just the thing for those days when an extra light layer is all you need. Finished dimensions: 20" x 41" before seaming. You will need at least 400

yards of fingering weight yarn and a size E hook.



#### Cosy with Crochet Cables Cushion (a little more advanced)

Saturday, August 23 & September 6

Fee: \$80/2 week class

This cushion cover is made with aran (worsted) weight yarn and has beautiful chunky cable patterns running up the length of the cushion. This stylish design would work in any colour and make a fantastic addition to any chair, sofa or bed. Making this cushion pattern is a great way to get started with crocheted cables, once you start you will find they are not as difficult as they look and crocheting cables can be very addictive!

It has a button up design on the back so that it can be easily removed for cleaning or changing up your style. Designed by Victoria Kairis.
