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What is Fisherman's Rib?

Pst...it's not Brioche!

Learn the basics of working Fisherman's Rib in the round. Pattern is free. Homework.

A Break in Tide Shawl

Learn how to work Fisherman's Rib back and forth. Pattern is \$7.
April 9, 16, & 23, Fee: \$75

A Break in Tide Shawl is a bottom-up construction, triangle shaped shawl featuring relaxing garter stitch complimented by sections of Fisherman's rib and slip stitch variations. This design begins with just a handful of sts and increases along the ends until completion. Bind off occurs at the top edge.

No-Gauge-Any-Yarn Crocheted Beanies

Love crocheting hats? Hate doing swatches? Let Edie show you how to crochet top-down beanie style hats without doing a gauge swatch. Make any size hat with any size yarn, and get a perfect fit every time. These hats are perfect for stash-busting and charity projects, and the techniques are easy enough for advanced beginning crocheters to master. More advanced students will have the opportunity to experiment with texture and colorwork patterns. Mastery of basic crochet stitches is required; some experience working in rounds from the center out is helpful. No homework.



Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving: Getting to Know Your Loom

with Georg Luxton
Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already), warp it and do a balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your loom together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg if you are uncertain.


