The knitting starts at the top with just a few stitches. While working the stockinette body flat, plant some

beads for seeds. The rest is worked in the round: stems and leaves of Japanese lace, Estonian lace buds and blossoming flowers sprinkled with dew-like beads (optional). You will need 372 of a fingering weight yarn and a size US 2 1/2 needle. In person class.

Intermediate Knitting/ Crocheting

You will learn more advanced techniques of your choice. For example, you can choose a simple cabled sweater pattern, a fair isle pattern, an intarsia pattern - the choice is yours! This class can be taken over and over and over and over. **All yarn must be purchased from MYS for Intermediate classes.**

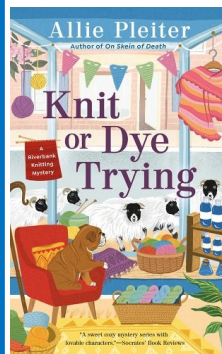

Correcting Mistakes (knit) with Darlene Joyce

Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle? Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will learn to pick up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of the row. The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. **Please pick up homework sheet.**

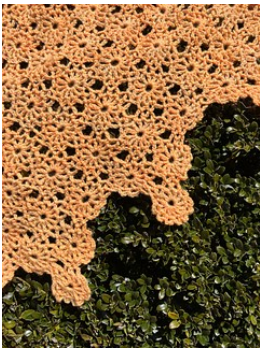


From Noro's new Spring/Summer 2022 magazine, Geshi in chevron stitch makes the a perfect top! Although the top only comes in one size, it is meant to be boxy and loose. If you need a smaller or larger size, you may need to reduce/increase the number of stitches or knit at a different gauge. You will need 2 skeins of Geshi and size US 5 & 6 needle.

Daisy Lace (Continuous Crochet)

It's a hug from a field of daisies! It appears to be hundreds of cute little daisy-shaped circles joined together, but your eyes deceive you! In reality, it's crocheted in

one piece, using the continuous crochet motif method. Intermediate Level. Designed by Edie Eckman.

Rigid Heddle Weaving: Color Play with Georg Luxton

Learn plaids and stripe color patterns with your rigid heddle loom. Knowledge of plain weave (tabby weave) necessary. Students must know how to warp a loom.

Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving: Getting to Know Your Loom

with Georg Luxton

Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already), warp it and do a balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your loom together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg if you are uncertain.
