

Knitting with Nick

Ruuvdu (in person) Saturdays, May 13 to 27 1-3 p.m. Fee: \$80

Ruuvdu is a funnel shaped cowl that begins with mosaic knitting

that transitions gradually into two-colour brioche. The cowl is knitted top down and in the round. Susanna Kaartinen drew inspiration for the design from her Saami roots and the traditional woollen Saami shawls with a plaid pattern — "ruuvdu" is an Inari Saami word that means square.





Earth & Sky was originally published as the first Westknits Mystery Shawl KAL in 2011. Three colors of West Wool Bicycle create this triangular top-down

shawl. Graphic parallelograms decorate the center of the shawl with a simple intarsia cross. You can bind off early after the three main color garter ridges for a smaller shawl or continue with the pattern as written for a larger shawl.



In Person Classes

Beginning Crochet



This class is for beginners. You'll get started with chain, single, and double crochet stitches. Chose a skein of Plymouth Encore and a H hook and you will be on your way!

Advanced Beginner Crochet

with Susan Kenyon (in person)

If you know the basic crochet stitches, and would like to use them in a creative way,

the **Advanced Beginner Crochet** class will help you take your crocheting to the next step. The class will cover a variety of stitches, including the popcorn stitch, puff stitch, and shell stitch. It will also cover working between stitches, working under one loop, and working around the post of the stitch.

You must know how to make the chain, the single crochet, and the double crochet stitches. Please purchase a medium weight yarn that is a medium color. Encore is a good yarn for practice. Don't use a variegated or textured yarn. Bring a size H or I crochet hook, or both.

Intermediate Knitting/ Crocheting

Intermediate Knitting/Crocheting

You will learn more advanced techniques of your choice. For example, you can choose a simple cabled sweater pattern, a fair isle pattern, an intarsia pattern - the choice is yours! This class can be taken over and over and over and over. All yarn must be purchased from MYS for Intermediate classes. Darlene takes Intermediate Crocheters (lefties too) in her classes.

Join us for some reading fun and good laughs! We will be reading "The Yarn Woman" by Brooks Mencher for our June 12th meeting.



Correcting Mistakes with Darlene Joyce Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle? Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will



learn to pick up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of the row. The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. Palazzo Top June 3 to 24 Fee: \$80

(No Class June 17)

Palazzo is worked sideways, and its textural variety makes the process pretty addictive. Estonian braids, slipped stitches, nupps and eyelets are accompanied by seed stitch and

stockinette for a balanced flowy fabric. The finished top has a lot of built-in positive ease and can be worn at least two ways - with a v-neck or a boat neck - which makes it a perfect throw-over piece for when a bit of extra warmth is needed.

If your goal is to make a **fair isle** yoke sweater from the "Strange Brew" book, then this class is where you should begin. You will plan your own hat using the free pattern from Tin Can Knits. The hat will become the "gauge swatch" for a future class on how to knit a yoke sweater with or without a steek. Please use the varn and stitches you plan to use for the sweater on the hat/cowl. Some experience with fair isle knitting required. Homework: Do ribbing before class.

you! In reality, it's crocheted in one piece, using the continuous crochet motif method.

Weaving (In Person)

Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving: Getting to Know Your Loom with Georg Luxton

Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already), warp it and do a balanced



weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your loom together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg.
