### Comet Trails Scarf (Fission Knitting) with Darlene FREE\* KAL via Zoom

Tuesdays, November 28 to December 12 7-8 p.m. CST

The **Comet Trails Scarf** features 2 different cable motifs of two colours on each side of the fabric! Knit the scarf as shown or mix up the colours to make it your own!



Fission Knitting is a

reversible knitting technique where two yarns are worked in a marl. It creates a super squishy fabric with different raised colorwork cables on each side of the fabric. This motif is designed so you will practice each Fission Knitting stitch before moving onto the next. But you won't have to wait – you will see the reversible magic start to happen within the first few rows!

This is a great project for advanced knitters looking to learn the Fission Knitting technique. **Designed by Mary W. Martin.**

Textured Treats Stitch Sampler with Edie Eckman (via Zoom)

Let's learn some new stitches! There's more to knitted texture than cables, seed stitch and bobbles. Explore more than a dozen unusual stitch patterns that add depth and pizazz to your knits, simply by manipulating the basic knit stitches.

Supplies: Smooth, light-color worsted-weight yarn and appropriate size needles, scissors. No homework



### **Chicory Cowl with June** Tuesdays, November 7 & 14,

Dive into double knitting and learn how to make a fabric that is stockinette on both sides!

Materials: BERROCO LANAS LIGHT (100 grs): 1 hank each #78101 Fog (C1) and #78110 Grapefruit (C2) -You will have enough for the hat too! Needles/ Notions: 16" / 40 cm circular needle, size 5 / 3.75 mm or size to obtain gauge & 16" / 40 cm circular needle, size 3 / 3.25 mm, if using Tubular Cast-On; Stitch markers, 1 a different color for BOR Cable needle (optional)



# **In Person Knit Classes**

**Brioche Starter Cowl** *with Nick Clewell* This pretty cowl is fun to knit and quick to make! It's knit in the round, which is easy to do in brioche. As its name implies, it's a good beginner's cowl or a good refresher. Pattern is \$5.99. Designed by Cynthia Spencer.

**Brioche Chain** *with Nick Clewell* Once you have mastered basic brioche you are ready to take it to the next level. This hat incorporates a cable for an added "twist" to the traditional two color brioche technique

**Correcting Mistakes** *with Darlene Joyce* Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle? Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will learn to pick

up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of the row. The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. **Please pick up homework sheet or find on our website.**

### Advanced Beginner Crochet with Susan Kenyon (in person)

If you know the basic crochet stitches, and would like to use them in a creative way, the **Advanced Beginner Crochet** class will help you take your

crocheting to the next step. The class will cover a variety of stitches, including the popcorn stitch, puff stitch, and shell stitch. It will also cover working between stitches, working under one loop, and working around the post of the stitch.

You must know how to make the chain, the single crochet, and the double crochet stitches. Please purchase a medium weight yarn that is a medium color. Encore is a good yarn for practice. Don't use a variegated or textured yarn. Bring a size H or I crochet

### Intro to Fair Isle Knitting with Darlene Joyce (in person class)

Learn to knit a basic fair isle hat. You will choose your own motifs and color combinations. Please bring a 16" circular needle size US 7 for a hat or a 24" circular size US 7 for a cowl. Homework: Cast on 100 stitches on a 16" circular needle



size US 5, join in the round and work in ribbing for 1 1/4". (If you are choosing to make a cowl, cast on 140 stitches on a circular needle US 5).

## **Tail Feather**

The garter-based lace pattern is fast and easy to knit, and looks great on both sides. Two width options are given. Materials: 470 to 610 yards of dk/worsted weight yarn, size US 7 needle & pattern.

The Runo Hat is written for worsted weight yarn and features



a very easy stitch pattern that makes an interesting texture. Our sample is in Madelinetosh Vintage.

Getting to Know Your Loom with Georg Luxton Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already), warp it and do a balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your loom



together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg.
