Cumulus Blouse

(knitting in person)

Tuesdays, November 11 to December 9 (No Class November 25), 6-8 pm Fee: \$140/4 week class.

The Cumulus Blouse is worked from the top down in stockinette stitch with two strands of thin mohair/silk yarn held together throughout. The design has a deep rounded V-neck.

All edges are finished with i-cord.

Darlene's sample is done with Emma's Suri Silk held together with Manos Del Uruguay Serena.
It is butter soft! You will also need the Ravelry pattern and a size US 7 circular needle.



Ice Breaker

(knit in person) with Darlene



Saturdays, November 1 to 15, 1 - 3 p.m. \$120/3 weeks.

Ice Breaker is a sleeveless layering top/popover, perfect for winter layering! And knit up seamlessly and in

bulky-weight yarn, it's a fun, fast knit too. It features a deep v neckline and simple eyelet stitch details along the hem.

Darlene is knitting her sample in Germantown Bulky & Silk Mohair Lux held together. Pattern on Ravelry.



Holiday Doodle Days: Knit Hat or Cowl with Darlene (knit in person)

Wednesday, November 19, 6 - 8 pm. Fee: \$40/2 hours

Using Jamie Lomax's clever "doodling" pattern, you will plan your own hat and start knitting it in class.

Materials: 5 contrasting colors of dk weight yarn (Darlene

used Vintage Baby dk) and a 16" circular needle in both size US 4 & US 5, stitch markers and purchased pattern.

Note: If doing the cowl, get 24" circulars in the same sizes.

Homework: Knit ribbing of your choice before class.

Students must have taken the Intro to Fair Isle class or know how to do stranded knitting.

Rooftop Landing with June Sorensen

Intro to Fair Isle Knitting with Darlene Joyce

Learn to knit a basic fair isle hat. You will choose your own motifs and color combinations. Please bring a 16" circular needle size US 7 for a hat or a 24" circular size US 7 for a cowl. Homework: Cast on 100 stitches on a 16" circular needle size US 5, join in the round and work in ribbing for 1 1/4". (If you



are choosing to make a cowl, cast on 140 stitches on a circular needle US 5).

Venezia is a precious, delicate shawlette, perfect for any single skein of fingering weight yarn. Worked from tip to tip, with a reversible

lace pattern and a diamond shape. It is framed by a gorgeous reversible diamond lace motif, and the main body of the shawl is worked in ribbing.

This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20".

How to Crochet a Triangle Scarf






Friday, December 5 11am-1 p.m.

This crocheted maple leaf applique can be used on its own or strung up as fall decorations, sewn onto blankets or sweaters... anything that you fancy!




Snowflake Ornament December 6
