Beginning Crochet





Berrry Trifle Cowl (Hybrid-In person/ Zoom)

with Darlene & Nick

Tuesdays, October 11 to 25, 4:30-5:30 p.m. Fee: \$40

Like a delicious layered dessert, Berry Trifle Cowl features a variety of textures brought together in a one-skein project. Layer by layer, explore different stitch patterns in a classic "just one more row" kind of a knit.

The cowl is worked from the top down in the round. Central increase line is echoed by Estonian braids which separate layers of different textures. Starting with the broken rib, proceed to the diagonal ribbed pattern, then blackberry stitch & finish the bottom off with some nupps.

Are you tired of necklines with holes or gaps? Would you like to learn professional ways of shaping a neckline and picking up stitches? Darlene will share all her secrets that she uses




to have perfect necklines. Homework required.

Correcting Mistakes (knit) with Darlene Joyce

Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle? Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will learn to pick up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of



the row. The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. Please pick up homework sheet or find on our website.

Learn to knit a basic fair isle hat. You will choose your

Homework: Cast on 100 stitches on a 16" circular needle size US 5, join in the round and work in ribbing for 1 1/4". (If you are choosing to make a cowl, cast on 140 stitches on a 24" cir-

cular needle US 5).

Designed by Imke Von Nathusius. Pattern will be out early September.


