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Meet Mary Martin & Learn Fission Knitting!





Tuesday, October 3 7-9 p.m. Fee: \$60

This is a virtual class.

Mary Martin is a knitwear designer based in Toronto, Canada who focuses on reversible fabrics. She has developed two reversible techniques: Fission Knitting and Fusion Knitting. Mary will be joining us to teach an introduction to Fission Knitting.

Fission Knitting with Mary Martin



Fission Knitting is a reversible

colourwork technique where the fabric is worked with two yarns held in a marl. The design elements are slipped stitches placed on both sides of the fabric. The marl is broken apart to work these stitches. The resultant fabric has a marled middle layer and an overlaid design on each side. It is possible to create a different cabled design on each side of the fabric.

In class you will work a small Fission Knit swatch to learn the most used stitches and cables. The emphasis will be on reading your knitting and applying the 3 Rules of Fission Knitting. You will learn the properties of Fission Knit fabric, why the technique works, managing your yarn and choosing suitable yarn/projects. There is no homework for the class.

Tendril Scarf Free* CAL

Tendril is a beautiful asymmetric lace shawl crocheted with only one skein of fingering weight yarn. When you are finished, only 2 ends to weave in! Perfect for that precious skein of Indie Dyed yarn you have been saving. The pattern repeat is an easy 4 row repeat with basic stitches, so once you have the re-

peat established, you can relax and crochet! *\$20 without yarn purchase.

Tunisian Crochet with Edie Eckman (via Zoom)

Tunisian crochet is a little bit crochet, a little bit knitting, and a lot of fun! Also known as Afghan Stitch, this hybrid technique uses a special crochet hook to quickly create blankets, place mats, scarfs, and garments. In this introductory class you'll learn the Tunisian Simple Stitch and the Tunisian Knit Stitch, as well as how to increase and decrease.



The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. Brioche Starter Cowl with Nick Clewell



This pretty cowl is fun to knit and quick to make! It's knit in the round, which is easy to do in brioche. As its name implies, it's a good beginner's cowl or a good refresher. Pattern is \$5.99. Designed by Cynthia Spencer.

Efflorescence Cowl with June Sorensen

The **Efflorescence Cowl** is knit in the round, from the bottom up, beginning and ending with ribbing stitches that flow through the floral motif. It features eyelets that make an airy pattern and



beautifully round bobbles, created with a crochet hook, to add extra interest and texture. The center of the blossoms is the result of an unusual 6 stitch cable. With a technique or two that may be new, the adventurous beginner will find a nice challenge while the experienced knitter will stay engaged throughout the project.




Sock Club Every Tuesday, 10 - 11 a.m.
