SWEATER!**

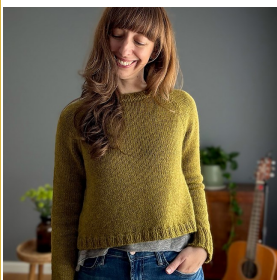

The Downbeat sweater embodies that same spirit of possibility, serving as the starting point for your creativity. Keep it simple and let the yarn take center stage, or use it as a backdrop for your own creative riffs. Either way, like every great song, it all begins with the downbeat!

This piece features top-down, seamless raglan construction with short rows to shape the neckline.

There are options for 2 different lengths as well as no body shaping or A-line body shaping.

You will learn more advanced techniques of your choice. For example, you can choose a simple cabled sweater pattern, a fair isle pattern, an intarsia pattern - the choice is yours! This class can be taken over and over and over and over. **All yarn must be purchased from MYS for Intermediate classes. Darlene takes Intermediate Crocheters (lefties too) in her classes.**

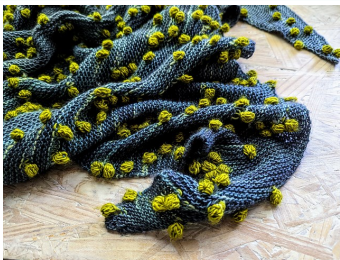

"Pop" Shawl New!
(Assigned Pooling Knit)
with Madalyn Fisher

Saturday, September 19,
1-3 pm. Fee: \$40/2 hours

Pop is a right triangle shawl that scatters big Assigned Pooling bubbles over the surface of a garter stitch sea. Assigned Pooling occurs when a change in stitch and texture is assigned to changes in color within a skein of variegated yarn. In this case, garter stitch is assigned to the background color to create a backdrop for the bobbles assigned to the accent color.

You need 100g skeins of fingering weight yarn designed for use with Assigned Pooling and a size US 5 needle.

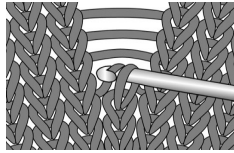


Knit Classes

Correcting Mistakes with Darlene Joyce

Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle?

Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will learn to pick up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of the row. The class will include exercises in dropping down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. **Please pick up homework sheet or find on our website.**

Advanced Beginner Knitting: Wicker Cowl

Learn how to knit very simple lace with knit two together and yarn overs. Choose any yarn and a 24" circular needle that is 2 sizes larger than what the ball band recommends. Kate knit a bunch of these for her bridesmaids!

Intro to Fair Isle Knitting with Darlene Joyce

Learn to knit a basic fair isle hat. You will choose your own motifs and color combinations. Please bring a 16" circular needle size US 7 for a hat or a 24" circular size US 7 for a cowl. Homework: Cast on 100 stitches on a 16" circular needle size US 5, join in the round and work in ribbing for 1 1/4". (If you are choosing to make a cowl, cast on 140 stitches on a circular needle US 5).

Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving: Getting to Know Your Loom with Georg Luxton

Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. All students will warp their loom and do a balanced weave using



worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Students have the option to rent a Sample It Loom for \$25. 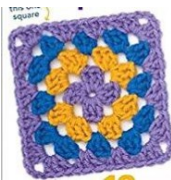

Beginner Crochet: Next Steps \$40/2 hour class (in person)

How to Crochet a Granny Square Wed, September 2, 3-5pm (with Darlene)



Learn to make a basic granny square that you can use as a coaster. You will need a "G" hook & 3 skeins of Coastal Cotton in contrasting colors.



How to Crochet a Coaster Wed, September 16, 1-3pm (with Nora)

Learn how to crochet a basic coaster. You will learn magic ring (optional) and how to read a basic pattern. There is a video to accompany the lesson. Materials: 4.5 mm crochet hook and a skein of Coastal Cotton.

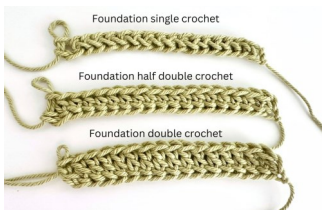
How to Crochet a Granny Stitch Scarf Tues, September 22, 3-5pm (with Darlene)

Learn how to crochet a granny stitch (not square) scarf. Darlene will demo the foundation single crochet for those students who want to try it. You will need one skein of Cumulus or Cumulus Dap-pled and a size 5.5 mm crochet hook.
