(knitting in person)

Fee: \$140/4 week class.



The Cumulus Blouse is worked from the top down in stockinette stitch with two strands of thin mohair/silk yarn held together throughout. The design has a deep rounded V-neck. All edges are finished with i-cord.

Darlene's sample is done with Emma's Suri Silk held together with Manos Del Uruguay Serena. It is butter soft! You will also need the Ravelry pattern and a size US 7 circular needle.

Do you love crisp air and the crunch of fall leaves, while walk-ing with a warm cup of coffee (in a reusable cup)? Do you hate

This autumn-themed cup cozy is the perfect addition to the aspiring low-waste, never-not-knitting, coffee fan!

The pattern is knit in the round, bottom up, using circular short needles (or DPNs or magic loop, if you prefer).

Some experience with Fair Isle Knitting required.

Seasonless – Patterns for Life is an unusual book that contains 5 fundamental knitwear pieces that are all customizable in terms of stitch pattern and shape. Using the same basic gauge in worsted weight yarn, you can make countless versions of the basic fingerless mitts, hat, vest, sweater,

and cardigan designs by combining your favorite colors, any of the four stitch variations (stockinette, bold stripes, mosaic, and textured), and different shaping options.

*Yarn is provided to "play with". You will need 3.25 to 3.5 mm DPNS or short knitting needles. If you want to make the full scarf, purchase 3 skeins of Koigu KPPPM.

Forest Friend Dolls

The Forest Friends Dolls pattern includes instructions and charts for three variations: Fox & Wolf, Raccoon & Deer.

June used HiKoo Simplicity. You can use dk weight scrap yarn and a size US 2 (2.75 mm needle).

Pattern on Ravelry. Designed by Ester Braithwaite. Students must have experience knitting in the round.

Find Your Way Beanie with Kate Joyce

The Find Your Way Beanie is knit using the mosaic method of colorwork. A perfect way to try your hand at 2 colors! It uses slip stitches and alternating colors every two rows, so no need to worry about floats and



tension! It's a really cool way to knit colorwork! Experiment with colors and have fun with it! Kate's hat is done in Malabrigo Rios.

Intro to Fair Isle Knitting with Darlene Joyce

Learn to knit a basic fair isle hat. You will choose your own motifs and color combinations. Please bring a 16" circular needle size US 7 for a hat or a 24" circular size US 7 for a cowl. Homework: Cast on 100 stitches on a 16" circular needle size US 5, join in the round and work in ribbing for 1 1/4". (If you



are choosing to make a cowl, cast on 140 stitches on a circular needle US 5).

Silver Falls Shawl With Madalyn

Thurs, 11 am- 1 pm, September 11 to 25 Fee: \$120/3 weeks

Second only to Washington in number, the waterways and cascading falls of Oregon

have become one of its most prized natural wonders. Silverton, OR is the gateway to one of its famous falls which this shawl is named for, Silverton Falls. With bands of eyelets, slipped stitches, and lace, I hope this shawl will be a fun technique filled project that makes you think of hiking, trees, waterfalls, and the beautiful gardens near Silverton, OR. A "six pieces of eight" shape and garter stitch tab cast-on mean this shawl will sit nicely around your shoulders for a cozy hug when the weather turns a bit chilly." Designed by Kelly Slack. Intermediate.

Kits Available for Purchase: Silver Falls Shawl Kit (Soft Donegal) includes yarn and pattern. You will need a size US 7 knitting 32" circular needle.

Weaving Class

Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving: Getting to Know Your Loom

with Georg Luxton

Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already),



warp it and do a balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your loom together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20".

Friday, September 5, 19 & October 3 Fee: \$120 2 - 4 pm 3 week class

Intro to Frame Weaving with Georg Luxton

Using a frame loom, students will learn some basics of weaving, including how to warp the frame, how to create some simple stitches and how to let the design process flow while making a simple wall hanging. No experience needed. Frames available at MYS for purchase or rental. Rentals are \$25.

How to Crochet a Ball Friday, September 12, 11 am -1 pm


You will start with a magic ring and learn to increase. In the next class you will learn how to decrease and finish you ball. Georg will go over pattern reading. Learning to crochet a ball is the stepping stone to all other crocheted toys (amigurumi).

How to Crochet a Granny Square Friday, September 19. 2 - 4 pm Saturday, October 18, 12 - 2 pm

Learn to make a basic granny square that you can use as a coaster. You will need a "G" hook & 3 skeins of Coastal Cotton in contrasting colors.

How to Crochet a Granny Stitch Scarf Saturday, October 4, 1 - 3 pm

Learn how to crochet a granny stitch (not square) scarf. Darlene will demo the foundation single crochet for those students who want to try it. You will need one skein of Cumulus or Cumulus Dappled and a size 5.5 mm crochet hook.

Aspen Croma Cowl

The Aspen Chroma Cowl is a wonderfully simple, yet textured cowl to add just a little something else to your outfit. You'll need 100 grams of a fingering weight yarn and a 3.5 mm (E) hook.

Campbell Everyday Cardigan

The Campbell Everyday can be worn all season and features a simple neckline and opening. The cardigan is suitable for beginners, using two simple stitches - the half double crochet and the treble crochet. There are no button holes or buttons used for this pattern. This is a free and



Chevron or Ripple? Let's Explore

Explore different chevron/ripple stitches, starting with relatively basic ones to more advanced stitches. Students should have a smooth worsted weight yarn like Encore or Vin-



tage and size H hook. We will make swatches and discuss how to use them to plan a scarf or blanket.

Corner to Corner Crochet

The Corner-2-Corner (C2C) crochet technique can be used to make

squares, rectangles, and triangles. It can be used to make scarves, cowls, shawls, and afghans. Susan's sample uses two skeins of Berroco Sesame.
