Learn Turkish toe, reverse heel flap and a stretchy bind off.






Rogue River Cowl April 13 to 27

Shine On Cowl with Kate Joyce Pick two colors of your favorite fin-


gering weight yarn and lose yourself in a deceptively simple knit. Shine On Cowl combines a clean lace stitch with a complex-looking, but easy to

Rigid Heddle Warping: Tips and Tricks

with Georg Luxton

Join this zoom class on WARPING the Rigid Heddle Loom if you want to review how to figure out how much yarn you need for a project and how to figure out which heddle to use. You will also learn how to warp a LONG length on the rigid heddle.

In-Person Classes

Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving: Getting to Know Your Loom with Georg Luxton

Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom (if they haven't already), warp it and do a



balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put your loom together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg if your are uncertain.

means that the way the warp and weft
strand colors interlock creates the
pattern. Knowledge of plain weave
(tabby weave) necessary. Students
must know how to warp a loom.


