# **Beginning Knitting**

During the first 2 classes, you will learn to cast on, knit, purl, increase, decrease & cast off. On the 3rd class session, you will pick out an easy project, learn to read knitting instructions & work on your chosen project for the remainder of the course. *Fee:* \$82/4 week class..

## **Technique Classes**

**Correcting Mistakes** *with Darlene Joyce* Are you tired of running into the shop every time the stitches fall off the needle? Come and learn how to correct common mistakes made while knitting. You will learn to pick up dropped stitches in stockinette, garter, and at the end of the row. The class will include exercises in dropping



down pattern stitches, picking up dropped stitches, and ripping out rows of knitting and getting stitches back on the needle. Please pick up homework sheet.

#### Finishing with Darlene Joyce

Learn professional finishing techniques that will make your sweater look "handmade" rather than "homemade." #### **Christmas Stocking**


with Darlene Joyce

Try your hand at fair isle knitting and while making a beautiful Christmas stocking in time for the holidays. We will use Nancy Lindberg's Christmas Stockings pattern and worsted weight yarn. Sample is made in Brown Sheep's Lambs Pride and a size 9 16" circular needles.

#### DK Brioche Bandana with Nick Clewell

This stylish unisex cowl is knit in the 2 color brioche stitch. The pattern is worked both in the round and flat. It's tapered in the back so it fits nice-ly around the neck and under the jacket. Students will learn how to decrease in brioche. One size fits most, this is warm and super soft. 24" around, 14" from cast on to point.



**Fair Isle Hat** *with Darlene Joyce* Learn fair isle knitting while making a hat. You will choose the fair isle motifs to make yours one of a kind. Materials needed are 5 colors of worsted weight yarn and a 16" circular needles in sizes US 5 & US 7 and double pointed needles in a

size US 7. Please cast on 100 sts, join in the round and do a k1, p1 ribbing for 1 1/4" before class.

Designed by Hannah Mann. Homework: Cast on and knit ribbing before class.

## Fiell CAL Fridays, October 11 to November 1 1 - 3 p.m.

This design uses mosaic crochet technique – a very simple and fun. Ornamental mosaic on the yoke is growing into mosaic panels on the body and sleeves

Only basic crochet stitches are used here (single crochet, double crochet and chains – US terms). And there are almost no ends to weave in, as we use one color for two rows and the yarn is changed in the end of the row without cutting.

The pattern contains full written instructions row-by-row together with charts, and you can follow both. Additionally a heavy photo-tutorial is placed in the very end of the pattern to guide you through every row of mosaic panels. Pre-registration required.

# **Crochet Classes**

#### **Beginning Crochet**

This class is for beginners. You'll get started with chain, single, and double crochet stitches. Chose a skein of Plymouth Encore and a H hook and you will be on your way! *Fee: \$82/4 week class.*

**Berlin Hat** with Pattie A aron Designed by Kiku Corner. This hat is named after the beautiful but gritty city Berlin, which she used to visit every summer as child. The Berlin Hat pattern works best in a tonal-dyed yarn. The Fiber


Seed Sprout DK (solids) would work well. The Berlin Hat pattern is multi-sized, so there are directions to fit toddlers, children, and adults. The adult pattern has options for either a slouchy fit or a closer beanie/toque fit.

# **Weaving Classes**

#### **Rigid Heddle Weaving: Color Play**

with Georg Luxton Learn plaids and stripe color patterns with your rigid heddle loom. Knowledge of plain weave (tabby weave) necessary. Students must know how to warp a loom.

#### Intro to Rigid Heddle Weaving: Getting to Know Your Loom

with Georg Luxton Learn the parts of the loom and weaving terminology. Students will assemble their loom, warp it and do a balanced weave using worsted weight yarn purchased from MYS. You can also have the MYS staff put



your loom together for you for a \$25 fee. This basic class is a spring board for more advanced weaving technique classes to come. If bringing own loom, make sure it is a rigid heddle and is no bigger than 20". Check with Georg if your are uncertain.

#### **Rigid Heddle Weaving: Log Cabin**

with Georg Luxton The Log Cabin pattern is a **color-and-weave** pattern which basically means that the way the warp and weft strand colors interlock creates the pattern. Knowledge of plain weave (tabby weave) necessary. Students must know how to warp a loom.

### Intro to Frame Weaving with Georg Luxton

Using a frame loom, students will learn some basics of weaving, including how to warp the frame, how to create some simple stitches and how to let the design process flow while making a simple wall hanging. No experience needed.

#### **Advanced Frame Weaving** *with Georg*

### Lace Pickup Techniques

smooth, not textured cotton, linen or other strong blend. Wefts can be the same as the warp or a variety of other yarns, weights and textures.
