

Surprise Sequence Sampler Scarf KAL

Materials: 500 yards of worsted weight yarn & size US 6 or 7 needle.

Notes:

- 1) Sequence knitting is when the repeat (or sequence) across a row is the same on every row. It is easy to memorize.
- 2) The first row will be the right side. Mark it with a pin.
- 3) The scarf will be about 52" long. If you want a longer scarf, knit more length of the each sequence rows (i.e. 8" instead of 7").

Cast on 54 sts.



1st Sequence: [k3, p1, k2] repeat on every row for 7"

Knit Stockinette Stitch for 2" (knit on RS, purl on the WS)

2nd Sequence: [k3, p1, k1, p1] repeat on every row for 7"

Knit Stockinette Stitch for 2"

3rd Sequence: [k2, p2, k2] repeat on every row for 7"

Knit Stockinette Stitch for 2", increasing one stitch on last purl row. (55 stitches)

4th Sequence: [k2, p2, k1, p1] repeat ending with a k1 on every row for 7"

Knit Stockinette Stitch for 2"

5th Sequence: [k2, p1, k1, p1, k1] repeat ending every row with k2, instead of k1.

Knit Stockinette Stitch for 2", decreasing one stitch on the last purl row (54 stitches).
