Class/Workshop Selection

There are many types of patterns to choose from to run a class/workshop around. For most one day workshops, I would suggest choosing a table runner which would allow most students to get a good grasp of the techniques taught without being overwhelmed. Several of the table runners have different techniques so it would be possible to run a series of "table runner workshops".

Another good option for a one day class/workshop would be a quilt with only one (two at the most) different units. This would allow students to get a good start on the units and start some of the unit joining techniques. More involved quilts require two - three days to allow enough time to get a better understanding of the techniques used for multiple unit quilts and their assembly.
