Don't forget! Reflections Gift Cards are perfect for that special stitcher in your life and they can now be purchased via the website!



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

To create a list or registry, create a Customer account and then from there create Registry or wish lists. You will also be able to search for lists by name or just browse all of the public lists. You will not be able to view lists saved as *private*.

Once you have created an account and verified the email address, you will find a Login link on the far right of the Navigation bar on the home page as pictured below.



To begin using the Gift Registry, log into the site.



Once you've signed in, you'll see a list of all Transactions you've done through the shop for both Shopping Cart transactions through the Website and Register transactions through the Point of Sale. You can click to view any of the transactions. From the navigation bar you will see an Account menu, and Gift Registry will be on the list.



If you click to open Gift Registry, you'll see a list of any registries you've made. You can click to Copy Link, so you can share a registry with others. You can also click to either View or Edit Details for any of your registries. Click the green +New Registry button to create a new one. Also, the Registry is not actually created until you click a confirmation link that is emailed to you as part of the process.

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
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To add items to a Gift Registry after you've done your Customer Login (as described above), you can go to the online store, and when viewing any item that has inventory listed there, you'll have the option of adding it to any registry you've created as pictured below.



Just a note: Out of stock items cannot be added to a Registry, but if they are added while in stock, and then the item becomes out of stock, they stay on the list but display the out of stock state.

I hope this feature and the ability to purchase a gift card via the website will be helpful for everyone. I learned quite a lot during the process of setting it up! Mostly that technology and I are not friends, and we never will be! At one point when customer support told me I needed to do something, my response was, "you are planning to talk me through that, right? Because if not, you better place your order for supper now as it's going to be a while!" This was at 3:00p.m. his time. Needless to say, he talked me through it.

Pony Needles

I've received several requests for the black Pony Tapestry point needles. I have placed my first order and should receive them in the next few weeks. I haven't tried them personally, but several of the stitchers have, and they like them-so look for those in the near future. I will be stocking them in sizes 24, 26, and 28.



Retreat Recap

Reflections' Fall Frills Retreat was held this past October 12-15 in Fremont, Nebraska at the Calvin Crest Retreat Center. There were twenty-seven stitchers in attendance over the course of the four days. This year the theme was Stitching to Infinity and Beyond. From the feedback I received, I believe everyone was pleased with the project and the retreat in general. The Retreat project was inspired by many conversations with stitchers regarding our need to stitch well past life expectancy. Grab a cup of something and enjoy the recap!

Upon arrival at Calvin Crest, everyone checked in at the desk, received their room assignment, and their name tag made by my sister.



Once checked into their rooms, the stitchers could head down to the stitching room and get themselves situated. After settling in it was time to stitch! Most people arrived on Thursday right at 2:00. I think we had three that didn't arrive until Friday. Because of this, Thursday and Friday until 2:00 were pretty chill with everyone getting to know each other and stitching the day away! On Friday after everyone's arrival, I had everyone stand up, give their name, and tell a bit about themselves, where they were from, or a bit about their stitching story.

That's it folks. The end of another successful retreat. It was a wonderful four days spent with a bunch of great ladies. Hope you enjoyed the recap!











