

Cutie Pie

You will need...

42—10” squares

2 yards— for sashing and first border

FQ for cornerstones

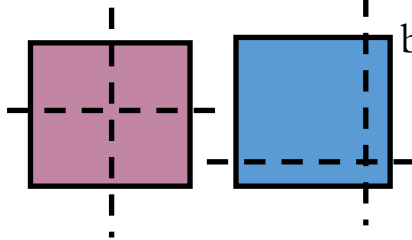
3/4 yard for second border

1 1/2 yard for third border



How to make...

Separate 10” squares into two stacks. Cut 21—10” squares into quarters. Mix them up and sew them back together into random four patches. Measure the size of the 4 patches you made. Trim the remaining 21—10” squares to match the size of the newly sewn 4 patches. Lay out pieces alternately into a 6 piece row, making 7 rows. You will join the squares with 1 1/2” sashing and 1 1/2” cornerstones. The first border will be 2”. The second border will be 4” and the last border is a 6” border.
