## Things you need:

- 1 – 10" layer cake (print)
- 1 – 10" layer cake (solid)
- $\frac{3}{4}$  yard – first border
- 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard – second border

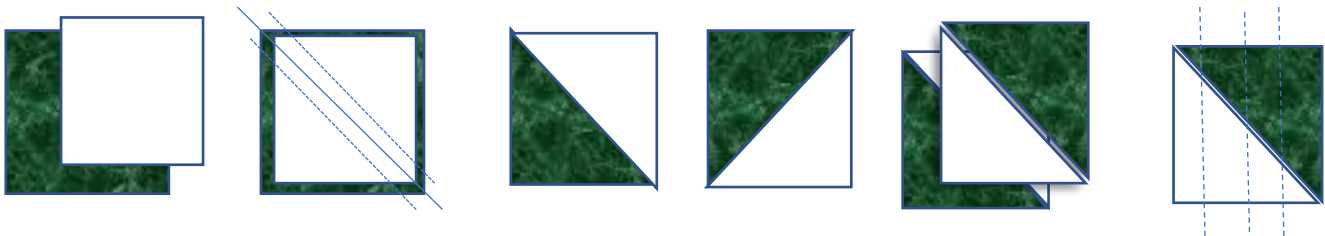
## Things that are helpful:

- Magic Wand Ruler
- Marking Tape
- Separating Containers/Bags
- Good Friends

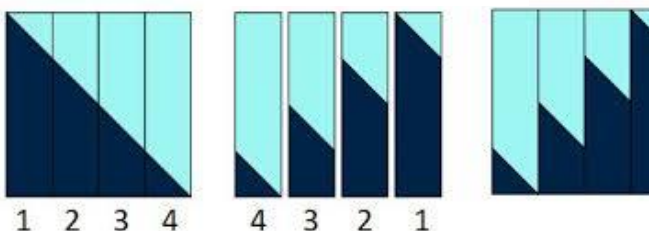


## Make It!

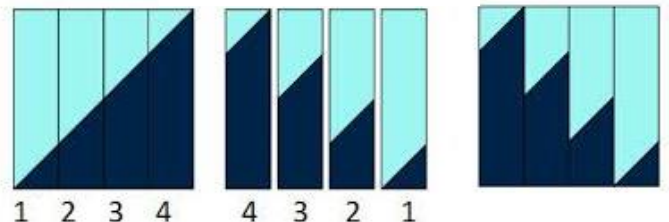
1. Layer 1 solid and 1 print 10" square right sides together. Mark corner to corner on the lighter colored square and sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on either side. Cut on marked line. This makes 2 half square triangles. Press squares open. They should measure 9.5" square. (You may trim to size).
2. Once squares are pressed you lay them right sides together again making sure the opposite colors are touching. Then it is time to do the math...
3. You will want to make four equal strips. If your squares were 9.5" you will need to cut 2  $\frac{3}{8}$ " strips. This is where the tape comes in handy. You put it on your ruler to make it easy to find the cut line over and over.
4. You get to choose your design now. You can do scrappy and mix all colors up or keep them same fabric in each square. The blocks that you will make will be slightly longer than wide. Several layouts on the back.
5. Sew together strips. You will need a go up and a go down. Lay the blocks together and make sure you like the design and then finish it up.
6. Enjoy !

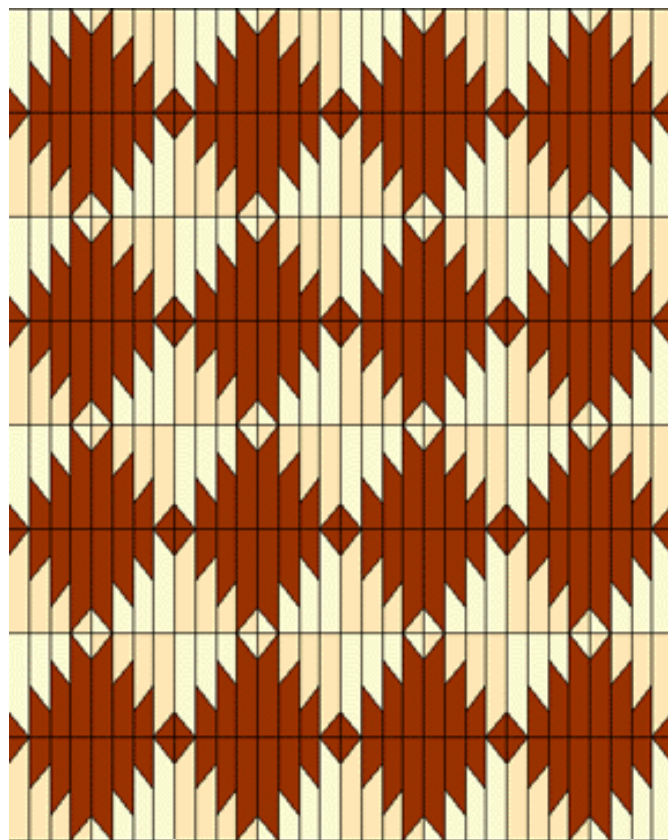


This is the go up...
