Prairie Point Hot Pad

use only 100% cotton fabrics

Materials:

28 5" squares (from charm pack, scraps, or 4 fat quarters) $2 - 12 \times 12$ fabric pieces for foundation front and back $1 \cdot 12 \times 12$ batting

Bias Binding

Instructions:

- 1. Mark a 12×12 square of foundation fabric like diagram 1.
- 2. Fold a 5" square as shown in diagram 2.
 - a. make four from fabric 1
 - b. make eight from fabric 2
 - c. make eight from fabric 3
 - d. make eight from fabric 4
- 3. Place the four from fabric 1 on top of the marked foundation top, matching the points.
- 4. Tack in place close to the tip of the point.
- 5. Place the eight from fabric 2 following marked lines.

(four on top of the existing points - four in middle of points)

- ***do not place more than 3/4" lower than the last points***
- 6. Tack in place close to the tip of the point.
- 7. Place the eight from fabric 3 and then fabric 4.

Tack in place close to the tip of the point.

- 8. Layer top, batting, and bottom foundation piece.
- 9. Stitch around top of the hot pad to secure bottoms of the prairie points.
- 10. Trim in circle (I used a plate for template)
- 11. Make a bias binding to go around the edge.

(hint - stitch on back side of hot pad, so when you turn you can top stitch on top for a neat finish)
