## Updated Full Pattern Mystery Quift 2012

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## Fabric Requirements - Cutting - Organizing

1. First thing to decide is what size and style of quilt you would like to finish up with.
a. Scrappy
i. Sort your scraps into light, medium, and dark. Decide whether you want your "pop" to be light or dark and be sure the background is the opposite. Use your mediums for the medium. I would not use a focus fabric if making this version. Just use additional of your "pop" fabrics.
b. Non-Scrappy
i. You will need to pick either 3 or 4 different fabrics for this quilt: a focus fabric ( or you can you more of your "pop"), a fabric that "pops", a medium and a background.
c. Controlled Scrappy
i. Very similar to the one above except use several different fabrics for each category. For example if you choose red for your "pop" color, choose several different reds and if purple is your medium, use several different purples...

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2. Second decide on what size quilt you would like to complete.
(all quilts are without borders)
a. Crib $36 \times 36$
b. Lap $48 \times 72$
c. Full/Queen $84 \times 84$
d. King $108 \times 108$

| Color \#2 <br> (background) | $11 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ | $23 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ | $51 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ | $81 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ |
| Color \#3 <br> (medium) | 1 | $13 / 4$ | 3 yd | $43 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ |

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Clue \#1
Place a Color \#3 rectangle vertically in front of you. Place a Color \#2 square over the top half of the rectangle. Make sure if you drew a line vertically that it goes from top left to bottom right. Sew corner to corner or right on top of the line. Flip and press the square toward the center. Trim the back two layers if desired.

## This makes Unit A.

You should have the following number of Unit A pieces:
Crib: 36
Lap/Twin: 96
Full/Queen: 196
King: 324


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Place a color \#1 square over one corner of a color \#2. If you wish to draw a diagonal line on the color \#1 square. Make sure it goes corner to corner, edge to edge. Sew directly on the line or in the middle of the square. Flip and press toward the corner.

## This makes Unit B.

You should have the following number of Unit B pieces:
Crib: 36
Lap/Twin: 96
Full/Queen: 196
King: 324


## Updated Full Pattern Clue \#3

Non-Scrappy
Sew a color \#2 strip to a color \#3 strip. Press toward color \#3.
Cross cut into $21 / 2$ " segments.

## Scrappy

Sew a color \#2 square to a color \#3 square. Press toward color \#3.

## This makes Unit C.

You should have the following number of Unit C pieces:
Crib: 36
Lap/Twin: 96
Full/Queen: 196
King: 324


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## Clue \#4

Place a Unit B in front of you so that the color\#1 is the top right corner. Now place a color \#1 square over the top left. You will stitch corner to corner. It is best to draw a line on the square so your stitches will be straight. Flip and Press after you stitch. If you wish trim the back layers.

## This makes Unit D.

You should have the following number of Unit D pieces:
Crib: 36
Lap/Twin: 96
Full/Queen: 196
King: 324


## Updated Full Pattern Clue \#5

Place a Unit C vertically in front of you so that the color \#3 is at the top and color \#2 is at the bottom. Sew a Unit A to the right side of the Unit C so the color 2 triangle is the top right corner. Press toward Unit A.

## This makes Unit E.

You should have the following number of Unit E pieces:
Crib: 36
Lap/Twin: 96
Full/Queen: 196
King: 324


## Updated Full Pattern Clue \#6

Using $1 / 2$ of your unit d's. Place a unit d with triangles on the bottom. Lay a unit E on each side. Make sure the little triangle is on the top.

## This makes Unit F.

You should have the following number of Unit F pieces:
Crib: 18
Lap/Twin: 48
Full/Queen: 98
King: 162


## Tpodated Futipatietan Clue \#7

Using the other half of your Unit D's, sew a unit d to the right and left sides of a focus square. Make sure that the color \#1 triangles touch the focus square. Press seams toward the focus.

## This makes Unit G.

You should have the following number of Unit G pieces:
Crib: 9
Lap/Twin: 24
Full/Queen: 49
King: 81


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## Clue \#8

Sew a unit $F$ to the top and bottom of the unit G. Press toward the unit g .

## This is your block!

You should have the following number of blocks:
Crib: 9
Lap/Twin: 24
Full/Queen: 49
King: 81


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## Clue \#9

Sew the blocks together as follows:
Crib: 3 rows of 3
Lap/Twin: 6 rows of 4
Full/Queen: 7 rows of 7
King: 9 rows of 9
