Quilt is 22" x 26".



Moda fabric:

Birds & Berries

Moda Candy:

20 sets of 3-2½" x 2½" matching squares

Background & Inner Border: (½ yard)

3-2½" x WOF strips

subcut 40-2½" x 2½" squares

2-1½" x WOF strips

subcut 2-1½" x 20½" strips

2-1½" x 18½" strips

Final Border & Binding: (½ yard)

6-2½" x WOF strips

set aside 3 strips for Binding

sew 3 strips together then cut

4-2½" x 22½" strips

Backing: ¾ yard

So yummy...you can't sew just one



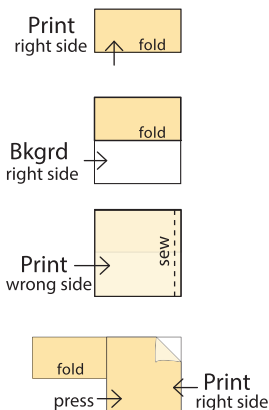

Quilt Construction

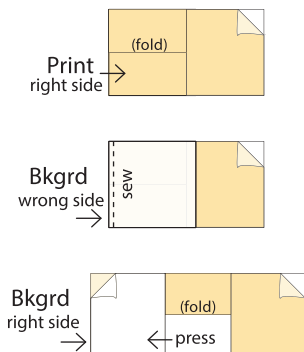
This is a fun technique for making dimensional bowties!

1 Bowties: Select $3-2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ matching prints and $2-2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ Background squares to make one Bowtie.

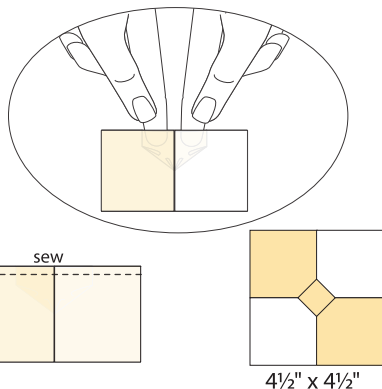
(A) Fold a print square in half, wrong sides together. Place on the right side of a Background square. On top of the print/Background square, place a print square, wrong side up. Stitch. Press open. Repeat to make 20 Bowties.



(B) Place the previous unit on the right side of a print square. Place a Background square on top, wrong side up. Stitch. Press open.



(C) The folded print forms a pocket. Open up the pocket by sliding two fingers into the opening and pulling the unsewn edges out on both sides to line up along the top edge. The center seams will now match up on the top edge of the unit. Sew. Press open. Repeat to make 20 Bowties.



2 Sew 5 rows of 4 Bowties. Combine the rows. Add the Inner Borders, sides first then top and bottom. Add the Final Borders, sides first then top and bottom. Layer, quilt and bind.
