# Century Pinwheels Quilt 

Introducing Andover Fabrics new collection: CENTURY SOLIDS by Andover Fabrics Quilt designed by Becky Cogan and Renée Nanneman

Quilt finishes 56' x 72''
48 Blocks: 8" x $^{\prime \prime}$
Little pinwheels form larger blocks that, when set side by side, form big pinwheels. What a fun optical illusion. Most of the construction is done with fast half-square triangles that make this engaging quilt easy enough for anyone with some piecing experience.

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. All measurements are cut sizes and include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. Borders are cut the exact lengths required plus ${ }^{1 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$ seam allowances. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide).

## ButternutSquash

Cut (24) squares $71^{\prime \prime} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{71} 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally twice to make 96 quarter-square triangles

## Cream

Cut (24) squares $71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times{ }^{711 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$, cut in half diagonally twice to make 96 quarter-square triangles
Cut (288) squares $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ for HST
Cut (24) squares $31 / 4^{\prime \prime \prime} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally twice to make 96 quarter-square triangles

## Paprika

Cut (24) squares $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 4^{\prime \prime}$, cut in half diagonally twice to make 96 quarter-square triangles
Cut (6) strips $1^{112^{\prime \prime}} \mathrm{x}$ WOF, pieced to make the following:
(2) borders $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(2) borders $1 \frac{112^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2^{\prime \prime}}{}$

## Redwood

Cut (2) borders $31^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 661 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (2) borders $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 561 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise
Cut (36) squares $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2{ }^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ for HST

## 8 Solids From each:

Cut (32) squares $2^{1 / 1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$ for HST (252 total)

## Spice

Cut (4) strips $2^{1 ⁄ 2 \prime} \times 68^{\prime \prime}$, cut lengthwise to make binding

## Backing

Cut (2) panels $40^{\prime \prime}$ x $64^{\prime \prime}$, pieced to fit quilt top with overlap on all sides

## Making the Quilt

1. The blocks use half-square triangles (HST). Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each Cream $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Place a marked square on a bright square, right sides together. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam on each side of the marked line; cut apart on the marked line. Press open to make pieced HST. Make 576 total HST.
2. Join 4 HST of the same bright fabric to make a small pinwheel. Make 144 pinwheels.

3. Referring to the triangle unit diagram, join Snow and Paprika 31/4" triangles together, short edge to short edge as shown, being certain that the Paprika patch is in the correct position. Make 96 units like this.

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4. Referring to the Block diagram, join Cream and Butternut Squash $71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangles as shown. Make 96 of these units.
5. To make a block, join 3 blocks and 2 triangle units into a diagonal row. Sew a unit from Step 4 to each side of the pieced row. Make 48 blocks.
6. Referring to the Quilt Diagram, join 6 blocks to make a horizontal row, rotating every other block as shown to form the design. Make 8 rows, noting orientation of the large Butternut Squash triangles. Join the rows.

## Finishing the Quilt

7. Layer the quilt with batting and backing and baste. Quilt in the ditch around borders and block patches. Quilt the large triangles as you wish. Bind to finish the quilt.
