

Finished Quilt Size 36" x 54"

FINISHING: Cut batting and backing 3" larger than top on all sides. Layer backing, batting and top together and baste or pin. When quilting is completed, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with $\mathbf{D}$ fabric.

## UNIT ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) C OST to (1) B OST, as shown. Make 24 and 24 reversed units.
2. Sew (1) F OST to (1) B OST, as shown. Make 24. Unit should measure 3-1/2".
3. Sew (1) E QST to one side of $\mathbf{B F}$ unit, as shown. Sew another E OST to bottom of BF unit, as shown. Make 24.
4. Sew (1) BC unit to top of unit made in Step 3. Sew another $\mathbf{B C}$ unit to side of sewn unit, as shown, to complete OST unit. Square unit to 4-3/4" $\times 9-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Make 24.


## QUILT CENTER ASSEMBLY

5. Using OST Units, A 9-1/4" squares, C 4-3/4" squares, C 4-3/4" $\times 9-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to create Quilt Center. Note the rotation of the QST Units in the Quilt Diagram shown below.


## BORDER ASSEMBLY

Measure width and length of the quilt top to ensure border sizes, below are our cutting instructions. Follow the Diagram on the last page.
6. "Sew (1) B $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 523 / 4$ " strip to left and (1) to the right of quilt center. Then sew (1) B $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 37 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and (1) to the bottom of quilt center.
