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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sidestogether has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut

four squares 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"

## From Fabric B, cut

three strips 2" x WOF. Subc ut:
fifty-two squares 2" x 2"
one strip 2-1/2" x WOF. Subcut:
sixteen squares 2-1/2" $\times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (cut once diagonally)
one strip $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut: sixteen rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
one strip 5-1/2" x WOF. Subcut:
seven rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
three squares 5-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From Fabric $\mathbf{C}$, cut

three strips 2" x WOF. Subc ut: fifty-one squares 2" x 2"
one strip 5-1/2" $\times$ WOF. Subcut: seven rectangles 2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ three squares 5-1/2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From Fabric D, cut

one strip 3-1/2" x WOF. Subcut: sixteen rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From Fabric E, c ut

eight strips 2" x WOF. Set a side for strip piecing.
four strips 3-1/2" x WOF. Subcut:
sixty-four rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
one strip 4" x WOF. Subc ut:
eight squares 4" $\times 4$ " (cut once dia gonally)
seven strips 6-1/2" x WOF. Subc ut:
eighty rectangles $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From Fabric F , cut

six strips 2 " $\times$ WOF. Set a side for strip piec ing. two strips 2" x WOF. Subcut:
thirty-five squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$
one strip $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut:
six rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
three squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From Fabric G, cut

one strip 2" x WOF. Subcut: nineteen squares 2" x 2"
one strip $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut: five rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ three squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$,

## From Fabric H, cut

six strips 2" x WOF. Set a side for strip piec ing.
two strips 2" x WOF. Subcut: thirty-five squares 2" x $2^{\prime \prime}$
one strip $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut: seven rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ three squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$,

## From Fabric I, cut

one strip 3-1/2" x WOF. Subcut: sixteen rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
one strip $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut: six rectangles 2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ three squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
two squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ (from scraps)

## From Fabric J, cut

six strips 1-1/2" x WOF
three strips 3-1/2" xWOF. Subcut: thirty-two squares $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
one strip $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Subcut:
four rectangles 2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ two squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
two squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ " (from scraps)

## From Fabric K, cut

six strips 3-1/2" x WOF

## From Fabric L, cut

two strips 5-1/2" x WOF. Subcut:
nine rectangles $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
three squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
three squares 2" $\times 2$ " (from scraps)

## From Fabric $N$, cut

two strips 2" x WOF. Subc ut: thirty-two squares 2" x 2"
two strips 10-1/2" x WOF. Subcut: thirty-two rectangles 2" x 10-1/2"

## From Fabric 0, cut

one strip 5-1/2" x WOF. Subcut: three rectangles 2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ two squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
two squares 2" $\times 2^{\prime \prime}$ (from scraps)

## From Fabric $P$, cut

one strip 5-1/2" $\times$ WOF. Subcut:
five rectangles 2" x 5-1/2"
two squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
two squares $2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ (from scraps)
From Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$, cut
one strip 5-1/2" x WOF. Subcut:
three rectangles 2" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ two squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
two squares 2" $\times 2$ 2" (from scraps)

## From Fabric R, cut

one strip 5-1/2" x WOF. Subcut:
two rectangles 2 " $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
three squares $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
three squares 2" x 2" (from scraps)
From the binding fabric, c ut
nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Step 1: Make the Panel Blocks

1. Sew $2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles short sides together, in the fabric combinations shown (refer to fig. 2), to make border units.
2. Sew a 2 " cream leaf square to both ends of the top a nd bottom border units.
3. Sew border units to the sides of each panel square, then sew border units to the top and bottom of each panel square (fig. 1)

4. Make eight Panel Blocks measuring 13-1/2" $\times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ each (fig. 2)

## Step 2: Make the 4-patch Blocks

5. Sew 5-1/2" squares together to make 4-patch units in the fabric combinations shown (refer to fig. 4).
6. Sew a $2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the sides of each 4-patch unit.
7. Sew a 2 " square to each side of the top and bottom border strips (refer to fig. 4 for fabric combinations), then sew borders to the 4-patch units (fig. 3).

8. Make eight 4-patch blocks measuring $13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ each (fig. 4)

## Step 3: Make the Inish Chain Blocks

9. Sew a Fabric H and a Fabric F 2" x WOF strip together lengthwise. Press seam allowance toward the green.
10. Repeat to make a second strip set.
11. Subc ut strip sets into thirty-two units 2" $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
12. Sew units together into 4-patch units (fig. 5), pressing the seams open. Make sixteen.

13. Sew a Fabric H and a Fabric E2" x WOF strip together lengthwise. Press seam allowance toward green.
14. Repeat to make four strip sets.
15. Subc ut strip sets into eighty units 2 " $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
16. Sew units together into 4-patch units (fig. 6), pressing the seamsopen. Make forty. Set eight aside for Star Blocks.

17. Repeat steps 13-16 to make forty 4-patch units using Fabric F and Fabric E (fig. 7)

18. Assemble Irish Cha in blocks as pic tured (fig. 8). Make sixteen.

## Step 4: Make Star Bloc ks

19. Make sixteen flying geese using 3-1/2 x 6-1/2" Fa bric E rectangles a nd 3-1/2" Fabric J squares (fig. 9) Place a Fabric J square RSTat one end of a Fabric Erectangle. Marka diagonal line on the wrong side of the square. Sew on the marked line and trim away the excess fabric, lea ving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance. Press toward the triangle. Repeat at the remaining end of the rectangle. The resulting flying geese block should measure $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} x$ 6-1/2".

20. Sew a 2" Fabric B and a 2" Fabric G square together to make a 2-patch unit. Make eight. Sew 2-patch units together to make four 4-patch units (fig. 10)

21. Sew Star blocks together, as pictured, using the 4-patch units from Step 3 in the outer border (fig. 11). Make four.

## Step 5: Make "Wreath" Blocks

22. Sew Fabric B triangles to two sides of a Fabric C 2" square, as pictured, then sew triangle unit to a Fabric E triangle to make a comer unit (fig. 12) Make sixteen.

23. Sew a 2" Fabric C square to both ends of a 2" x 3-1/2" Fabric B rectangle. Make eight. Repeat with 2" Fabric B squaresand 2" x 3-1/2" Fabric D rectangles. Make sixteen (fig. 13).

24. Sew units long-edges together, to make border units. (fig. 14)

25. Sew Wreath blocks together as pictured (fig. 15) Make four.

Step 6: Assemble the Quilt (Refer to Assembly Diagram)
26. Sew the Panel Blocks and 4-Patch blockstogether into four rows of four blockseach. Sew rows together to complete the center.
27. Piece the Fabric J 1-1/2" X WOF strips short sides together and sew to sides, top and bottom of the quilt center. Trim as you go.
28. Repeat to sew on next border, using the 3-1/2" Fabric K strips.
29. Sew Irish Chain, Star and Wreath blocks together, as pictured, to make outer borders. Pay close attention to the block orientation.
30. Sew outer side borders to quilt, then sew top and bottom borders to quilt.

Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind a nd enjoy!
