## Quilt finished 48' x 64"

## Cutting Directions

Note: Read assembly directions before cutting patches. Borders are cut to exact length required plus $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. WOF designates the width of fabric from selvedge to selvedge (approximately 42 " wide).

Fabric A Cut (3) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (48) $21 / 2$ " squares.

Fabric C Cut (1) $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2$ " strips and (12) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (24) $1^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
Cut (1) $51 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strip into (24) $1^{1 / 2 \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2}$ " strips.
Cut (1) $71 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips and (12) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric D $\quad \operatorname{Cut}$ (1) $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2$ " strips and (12) $1 \frac{1 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 " ~ s t r i p s . ~}{\text { s }}$
Cut (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ strips and (12) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (1) $71 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips and (12) $11 / 2$ " $61 / 2$ " strips.

## Fabric I

Cut (1) $61 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (1) $8^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2$ " $\times 81 / 2 "$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 7^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (1) $3^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (24) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (24) $1 \frac{1 / 2 " x}{} 41 / 2 "$ strips.
Cut (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2$ " x $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (1) $8 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 7^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
Cut (1) $61 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (1) $81 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times{ }^{11 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (1) $6^{1 / 2 "} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

Cut (1) $81 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ x $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (12) $1^{11 / 2 "} \times{ }^{21 / 2 "}$ strips.

## Cutting Directions - Cont.

Fabric J
Cut (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2$ " x $31 / 2 "$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 2 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ strips.

Cut (1) $71 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (12) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2 "$ strips and (12) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.

Backing Cut (2) 56 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make (1) 56 " $\times 72$ " backing.

## Making the Quilt

1. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to the left side of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top of the Fabric A square to make (1) AB block (Diagram 1).

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2$ " Fabric E strip to the right side of the AB block. Sew (1) $1 / 1 / 2$ " $41 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the bottom of the AB block to make (1) AE block (Diagram 2).

3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 4^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C strip to left side of the AE block. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top of the AE block to make (1) AC block (Diagram 3).
4. Sew (1) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric F strip to the right side of the AC block. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " x $61 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the bottom of the AC block (Diagram 4). Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " x 6 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the left side of the AC block. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top of the AC block to make (1) AD block (Diagram 5).

5. Sew (1) $1^{1 / 2 "} \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the right side of the AD block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the bottom of the $A D$ block to make (1) Block One (Diagram 6).

Block One make 12

6. Repeat Steps $1-5$ to make (12) Block Ones total.
7. Repeat Steps 1-5 using the fabrics shown in Diagram 7 to make (12) Block Twos.

8. Repeat Steps $1-5$ using the fabrics shown in Diagram 8 to make (12) Block Threes.

9. Repeat Steps $1-5$ using the fabrics shown in Diagram 9 to make (12) Block Fours.

## Finishing the Quilt

13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric $G$ strips together, end to end with a 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.

12. Sew the (8) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
