# \* EUCKIE\*

Finished Quilt Size: 55" x 67" Finished Block Sizes: 12"

Be sure to read through instructions before beginning. Cutting instructions include 1/4" seam allowance. Yardage is based on 42" of usable fabric width. All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) unless otherwise stated. Press all seams as you assemble your blocks. Border lengths given are exact measure ments. You may want to cut borders slightly longer to allow for variations in seams and mitering corners.

# **Fabric Requirements:**

Square Dance White 101.115.01.1	7/8 yard
Lucky Charm Black 101.115.02.1	3/4 yard
Lucky Charm White 101.115.02.2	1/2 yard
Durango Red 101.115.03.1	5/8 yard
Fringe Red 101.115.04.1	3/8 yard
Sirius Turquoise 101.115.05.1	1 yard
Sirius Black 101.115.05.2	1-3/4 yards
Backing - Any Luckie Fabric	3-1/2 yards

#### For Stars:

From Sirius Black - Cut (24) 4-1/2" squares for corners. From Sirius Black - Cut (6) 5-1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally in both directions to create 4 quarter-square triangles for a total of 24.

From Lucky Charm White - Cut (6) 4-1/2" squares for centers.

From Lucky Charm White - Cut (12) 5-1/4" squares. Cut squares diagonally in both directions to create 4 quarter-square triangles for a total of 48.

From Sirius Turquoise - Cur (6) 5-1/4" squares. Cut diagonally in both directions to create 4 quarter-square triangles for a total of 24.

Using the diagram as your guide, assemble the block as shown at top right. Sew together the 1/4 square triangles into hourglass units; sew the squares and hourglass units together to create rows, sew the rows together to create the block.

## For Boots:

## From Sirius Turquoise (Block Background)

Cut (6) 7" x 12" rectangles (A1).

Cut (6) 2" x 3" rectangles (A4).

Cut (6) 3" x 3-1/4" rectangles (B2).

Cut (6) 3" x 11-1/2" rectangles (C1).

From Sirius Black (Boot Heel) cut (6) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles (B1).

# From Fringe Red (Boot)

Cut (2) 1-1/2" x 3-1/4" rectangles (A2).

Cut (2) 4-1/2" x 9" rectangles (A3).

Cut (2) 7" x 12-1/2" rectangles (C2).


# From Lucky Charm Black (Boot)

Cut (4) 1-1/2" x 3-1/4" rectangles (A2).

Cut (4) 4-1/2" x 9" rectangles (A3).

Cut (4) 7" x 12-1/2" rectangles (C2).

### Feather Diagram - Make 2 Horseshoe Diagram - Make 2





**Boots Cont:** 

# 6-1/4" - Paper Piecing Diagram



Print out the paper-piecing pattern for the boot. The right side of A1 should measure 6-1/4" with an 1/8" seam allowance. This pattern should be enlarged 200% so that the right side of A1 measures 12-1/2" with a 1/4" seam allowance. You will need six copies of the paper-piecing patterns. Using the diagram as your guide, paper-piece the boots using the rectangle shapes in the order listed below.

A1 + A2 + A3 + A4 = A Unit

B1 + B2 = B Unit

C1 + C2 = C Unit

Attache the B Unit to the C Unit and than attach this completed unit to the A Unit to create the boot block. It should measure 12-1/2" unfinished.

#### Quilt Assemble:

Using the quilt diagram, assemble the stars and boots together in rows. Sew the rows together and attach borders as follows:



#### **Borders:**

1st Inner Border from Sirius Black - Cut (5) 1-1/2" x WOF strips. From these strips, cut (2) strips equal to top and bottom measurement of the quilt. Add these strips to top and bottom. Sew the remaining strips together to create a single strip. Measure the quilt again and cut this strip into two strips the length of the sides of the quilt. Add one strip to each side.

2nd Inner Border from Durango Red - Cut (6) 3-1/2" x WOF strips. From these strips, cut (2) strips equal to top and bottom measurement of the quilt. Add these strips to top and bottom. Sew the remaining strips together to create a single strip. Measure the quilt again and cut this strip into two strips the length of the sides of the quilt. Add one strip to each side.

3rd Inner Border from Sirius Black - Cut (7) 1-1/2" x WOF strips.

Outer Border from Square Dance White - Cut (8) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew these strips together in a single strip. From this strip, cut (2) strips equal to top and bottom measurement of the quilt. Add these strips to top and bottom. Measure quilt again and cut the remaining strip into (2) strips the length of the sides of the quilt. Add one strip to each side.

### **Binding:**

From Sirius Black - Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together to create a single strip. Fold in half lengthwise, press and attach to sides of quilt after quilting.
