Christmas Panel Quilt!

Framing the Panels

1. Sew the 1½" x 15½" red stripe sashes to the sides of the three large panels. Press toward the

sashing.



2. Sew the two 1½" x 17½" red stripe sashes to the top and bottom of the center panel. Repeat with the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " sashes for the two remaining panels. Press toward the sashes. Set aside.





3. In the same manner, sew red stripe sashes 1½" x 9½" to the top and bottom of the 9½" square panels. Press toward the sashing. Sew the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " sashes to the sides. Press toward the sashng. Set aside.



- 4. Sew the 13/4" x 4" green stripe sashes to the top and bottom of eight of the 4" fussy-cut squares from the panel. Press toward the sashes. Sew the $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " sashes to the sides of the blocks. Press toward the sashina. Set aside.
- 5. Sew $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 4" sashes to the top and bottom of the remaining ten 4" fussy-cut squares from the panel. Press toward the sashes. Sew the 3/4" x 41/2" sashes to the sides of the blocks. Press toward the sashes. Set aside.

Star and Tree Blocks

1. Mark a diagonal line on all of the red snowflake $2\frac{1}{2}$ squares. Position a red square on top of a black snowflake 2½" x 4½" rectangle, right sides together. Sew on the line. Trim away the corner, leaving a ¼" seam. Press toward the red triangle. Repeat on the opposite end of the black rectangle. Make a total of 40 units. At this point they should each measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".







2. In the same manner using the green $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $4\frac{1}{2}$ rectangles and the black snowflake 2½" squares, make 6 flying geese units for the trees. At this point the units should measure 2½" x 4½".



3. Arrange 3 units from step 1, two 2½ "black squares, one small framed square and one large framed square as shown. Sew together, press.



4. Arrange 3 units from step 1, two 2½ "black squares, one small framed square and one large framed square as shown. Sew together, press.



5. Sew 3 black snowflake squares and two units from step 1 above to make a row. Press.



6. Sew the Step 3, 4 and 5 units together to make a large square. At this point the square should measure 14½" square. Repeat to make a second block.



7. Arrange 2 small framed blocks, 4 Step 1 units and 2 green flying geese units to make a row. Make 2. Press.

8. Arrange 2 large framed blocks, 1 small framed block, 3 step 1 units and two 2½" black squares to make a row. Make 2. Press.




9. Sew 3 step 1 units and 4 black squares together to make a row. Press. Make 2.



10. Sew the step 7, 8 and 9 rows together to make 2 large partial blocks. At this point the blocks should measure 12½″ x 20½″.



11. Sew the 13/4" x 111/2" sash to the lower left hand side of one of the larger square framed blocks. Sew the 1-3/4" x 121/2" black sashing to the bottom of the unit. Press toward the sashing. Sew this block to the left side of one of the step 10 blocks. Press toward the red sashing. This makes the lower left segment of the quilt. Repeat for the upper right segment of the quilt, referring to the picture for arrangement of the units.





12. Sew the black snowflake 2½" x 13½" sashing to the top of the upper left framed rectangle. Press toward the sashing.

Repeat for the lower right rectangle, sewing the sashing to the bottom of the rectangle.

13. Sew 2 units from step 1, one green flying geese unit and 3 black squares together to make a row. Press. Make 2 rows.

14. Sew the two 1¾" x 5½" black sashes to the upper left and lower right of the center framed block. Press toward the red frame. Sew the step 13 rows to the top and bottom of the center framed block. Press toward the block.




15. Sew the remaining large units together with partial seams where the units are joined around the center. Finish sewing the partial seams, and your quilt top is ready for borders!

Borders

- 1. Measure the quilt through the center. Mark all the borders to that length, starting 6" from the end of the border strip. Match the centers and border lengths to the quilt edges. Sew the top and bottom border first, leaving the last 1/4" at the corner unsewn and backstitching. Repeat for the side borders, again leaving the last 1/4" unsewn. At the corners, the seams should just touch, not catching any extra fabric in the seam.

 Press toward the borders.
- 2. Fold the quilt right sides together on the diagonal as shown. Match the borders.

Draw a 45° line from where the seams meet at the corner to the edge of the borders. Sew on that line, trim away the excess fabric after checking the corner is sewn properly. Repeat at each of the corners of the quilt.



Finishing the Quilt

Layer the backing wrong side up, the batting and the quilt top right side up. Baste, then quilt as desired. Finally, bind the quilt.
