IRONWOOD RANCH

Please read all instructions carefully AND identify all fabrics before beginning.

All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut selvege to selvege, unless stated otherwise.


1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - Referring to the quilt image, fussy cut strips, the length of fabric parallel to selvege: (2) 10-1/4" x 57-1/2" and (2) 10-1/4" x 39-1/2" multi-stripe borders

Fabric B - Fussy cut (4) 10-1/4" squares with motifs centered


Fabrics C, F, and J - From each fabric:

Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut


(3) 9-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 6 triangles

Fabrics D, E, I, and L - From each fabric:


Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut

(2) 9-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 4 triangles

Fabric G - Cut (7) 2-1/2" strips (binding)

Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut (3) 9-7/8" squares then cut in half diagonally  for 6 triangles

Fabric H - Cut (1) 9-7/8" strip, subcut

(4) 9-7/8" squares then cut in half  diagonally for 8 triangles

Fabric K - Cut (12) 2" strips, sewn together end to end and cut into (2) 2" x 77", (2) 2" x 62", (2) 2" x 54-1/2", and (2) 2" x 39-1/2" borders

2. Refer to Quilt Layout (Page 2) for arrangement and placement of blocks and borders.

3. Arrange blocks in 6 rows of 4 blocks each. Sew blocks into rows. Sew rows together.

4. Stitch 2" x 54-1/2" **Fabric K** borders to right and left sides of quilt center. Add 2" x 39-1/2" **Fabric K** borders to top and bottom.

5. Sew 10-1/4" x 57-1/2" **Fabric A** borders to right and left sides of quilt. Stitch 10-1/4" **Fabric B** squares to both ends of each 10-1/4" x 39-1/2" **Fabric A** border then add these to top and bottom of quilt.

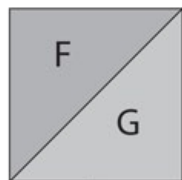
6. Stitch 2" x 77" **Fabric K** borders to right and left sides of quilt. Add 2" x 62" **Fabric K** borders to top and bottom.

7. The quilt measures approximately 62" x 80" (unfinished). Make backing (**Fabric M**) at least 8" larger than the top.

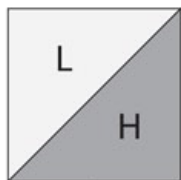
8. Layer and baste top, batting, and backing together. Quilt as desired. Attach binding (**Fabric G**) and enjoy!!

2. Piecing Order:

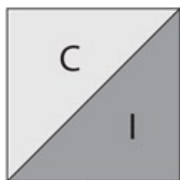
1. Stitch 9-7/8" triangles together along long edges to make the number of blocks shown (9-1/2" square finished).



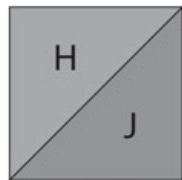

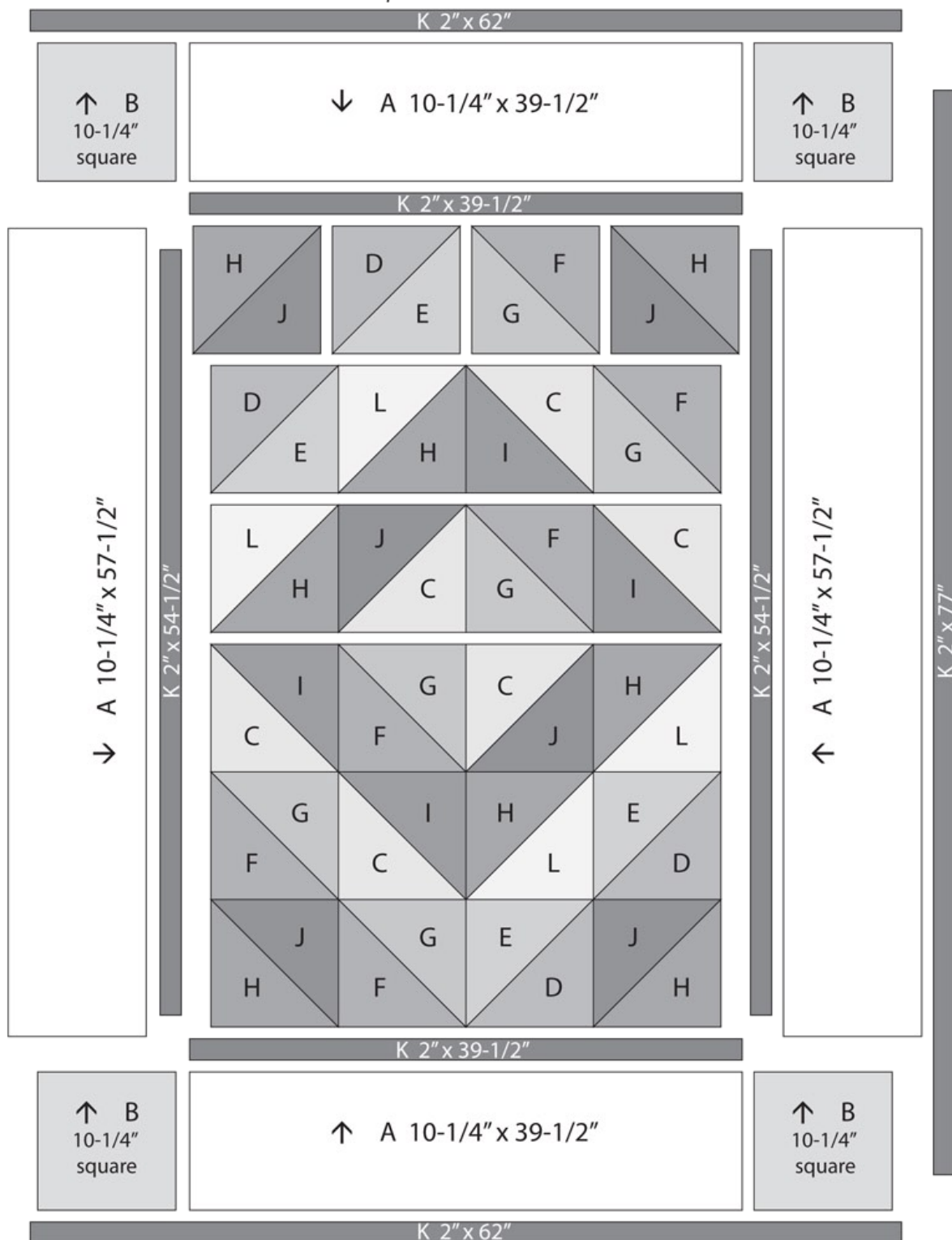
