Class Name Here: 2026 Wonky Tree Improvisationally Pieced Quilt

Explore improvisational piecing by making this fun Wonky Tree Quilt! Piecing a quilt improvisationally is very freeing – there are no corners to match, straight lines are optional and the end result is truly one of a kind! The sample quilt is 60" square, but you can make yours as large or as small as you want! You could make a fun holiday table runner, this would also make a fantastic baby quilt!

- Special skills needed prior to signing up for class: Correctly thread machine (top & bottom), Basic quilt piecing, safe and confident use of rotary cutter w/ruler.

Class Specific Supplies purchased from Cotton Gin will receive a 15% discount. (we strongly encourage you to purchase your supplies one week prior to arrival for class):

- Pattern: Wonky Tree Improvisationally Pieced Quilt by Candy Glendening
- Fabric (**for a 60"-ish square quilt**) :
 - 4 yards of background fabric. This fabric should either be really dark or light, it could be all the same fabric, or several variations of the same hue. Either solid colors, hand dyed fabrics, or batiks will work well. If you want to use patterned fabrics, the patterns should be small, non-directional and low contrast.

- (8) fat eighths of fabrics, six of them should contrast sharply with the background fabric. (Test this by spreading out your background fabric, laying your other fabrics on top of the background and view with the Ruby Ruler – you should be able to easily see the tree fabrics sitting on top of the background.)
- Notions:
 - Small ruler (1" x 12" or similar)
 - Medium square ruler (12" or larger)
 - Large ruler (6" x 24", last class only)
 - Rotary Cutter and personal cutting mat.
 - Pins and pin cushion
 - Scissors and Seam Ripper
 - Mini Iron and Iron Mat
 - Ruby Ruler (or some other value checking tool)
- Hardware
 - Hardware:
 - Sewing Machine (in good working condition)
 - Presser Feet including ¼ in foot & standard sewing foot
 - Bobbins
 - Needles - universal 80/12 (please bring a new needle for every session)
 - Coordinating Thread

Supplies from Home:

- Sewing Machine (in good working condition)
 - Presser Feet including and Open Toe Foot
 - Bobbins
- Standard sewing supplies
 - Rotary Cutter and personal cutting mat.
 - Pins and pin cushion
 - Scissors and Seam Ripper
 - Mini Iron and Iron Mat
 - Erasable Marking tool
- Needles- Universal or 80/12 (please bring a new needle for every session)

Class Guidelines:

You will be sharing our classroom space with others. When you join our Cotton Gin community, please plan accordingly and respect the following guidelines:

CLASS FEES:

- ❖ Class fees must be paid at the time of registration. Your spot in a class will only be secured once you have paid.

- ❖ Classes typically hold up to 8 students, with a minimum of 2-4 to be held.
- ❖ There are NO REFUNDS. Store credit will be given if the course is canceled or for an unforeseen family emergency.

CLASS SUPPLIES:

- ❖ A cutting station and ironing boards are provided to be shared by all participants. When a large amount of cutting or ironing is needed, please plan to do it at your table or home.
- ❖ If noted in the class supply list, a limited number of kits will be available. We encourage you to purchase your kits early and fabric before class day.
- ❖ Basic sewing supplies are required for all classes. A supply list of material and tools required for each class is available.
- ❖ If you don't have one in working order, you may rent our Husqvarna Viking Emerald for \$25 per class + required bobbin pack purchase.

CLASS ETIQUETTE:

- ❖ Classes will start on time; please arrive 10-15 minutes early to set up for class.
- ❖ All your supplies should fit on and under your single table (24" x 40").
- ❖ All bags & rollers should fit under your table or be returned to your car.
- ❖ **No eating or drinking in class please.** Water in a spill-proof container is OK.
- ❖ Avoid perfume or strong scents (for our friends with allergies).
- ❖ For safety reasons, participants should be 16 or older unless otherwise noted.
