

Class: #105 Traditional Hand Quilting

Skill Level: Beginner

Fabric:

Two 18" square pieces of light colored fabric, 100% cotton
18" square batting, Quilter's Dream Polyester recommended

Pattern:

In class you will be working light colored cotton fabric to learn and practice the hand quilting technique.

Project Supplies:

Thimble—a thimble must is highly recommended.

Between quilting needles—size 9 or 10

Washable marking pen or pencil

Ruler—12- 18" clear rotary cutting ruler

An 8-10" embroidery hoop would be helpful

If you cannot see fine stitches, be sure to bring glasses.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

Hand quilting thread—Guttermann cotton is recommended

Straight pins

Safety pins

4" sharp scissors

If you have a project or pattern you are planning to hand quilt, bring it along and we will discuss the quilting.

If your class runs through lunch time, you may want to bring a portable lunch. There is a small refrigerator available.
