**Class: 116—Beginning Free Motion Quilting**

The pre-requisite for this class is #114 Basic machine quilting or the equivalent. This class

assumes that you know how to do basic basting and marking of a quilt top.

## Fabric:

- Backing fabric and top fabric about 34 x 34--use a light fabric such as muslin or cream or white tone on tone. Please do not bring a fabric with any kind of print on it. Please use your top and bottom fabric with the batting and make a pin basted or fused quilt sandwich.
- Batting--very flat cotton or poly (this means something very flat with nothing fluffy--if it is more than 1/4" thick, it's too thick)--Dream cotton or dream poly are good or the equivalent. Please buy your batting at Quilted Fox so that you will have the right kind.

## **Project Supplies:**

- Sewing machine in good working order with extension table if available. Start with a fresh needle--topstitch 80 is best. Please bring your cord, foot pedal and manual.
- Free motion foot to fit your sewing machine. An open toe free motion foot is best but bring what you have.
- Quilter's gloves--if you have them
- If you have a quilt top that you want to quilt, bring it and we will discuss quilting options.

## **Basic Sewing Supplies:**

- Basic sewing supplies such as scissors, ripper, empty bobbins, extra machine needles, pencil
- Thread-- cotton or polyester 50 wt or thinner in color that will show up well on your light fabric. i.e. dark brown, navy, red, or black. Bring a bobbin filled with a contrasting thread. For example, if your top thread is black, bring red in the bobbin.

If your class runs through lunch time, you may want to bring a portable lunch. There is a small refrigerator available.
