

Class: 130-Basic Machine Applique

Skill Level: Beginner

Fabric: Please bring a very light color for the background—should be at least 10” x 15”. Also bring a couple of scraps—you’ll need at least two colors. Solid colors or tone on tone work best.

Pattern: Provided in class

Project Supplies:

- Fusible web—1 yd. Heat and Bond light (available at The Quilted Fox)
- Open toe foot for your sewing machine (if you have one. If you aren’t sure, bring all your machine feet)
- Freezer paper—at least 10 x 15 piece
- Sewing machine capable of adjustable zig zag stitch. Be sure you know how to adjust the stitch length and width. Bring your manual, if you have any doubts about the operation of your machine.
- Pen
- Paper scissors and fabric scissors
- Bring a spool of thread that will contrast with your scraps. Also bring a bobbin that contrasts strongly with your spool of thread. For example, if your top thread is black, bring bright red for the bobbin thread.

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Pins, seam ripper

If your class runs through lunch time, you may want to bring a portable lunch. There is a small refrigerator available.
