#225 – Borders and Bindings

You have finished your quilt – now what? Have you wanted to learn how to measure and attach borders without ripples? How to do straight or bias bindings? How to sew a mitered corner on a border? How to sew bindings by machine?

This will be a technique class and you will go home with samples and written instruction for: straight borders, mitered corners, straight and bias bindings and finishing bindings.

Supplies:

- 18" quilt sandwich: Front, batting and backing; trimmed squarely and quilted. If unsure how to square up, please have quilted and will demo in class.
- 2 width of fabric strips cut 2 ½" wide (for binding)
- 12" square or leftover quilt block
- 1 width of fabric strip cut 3" (for mitered corners)
- Basic sewing supplies including pins, ripper, rotary cutter and ruler, matching thread
- Sewing machine with 1/4" foot and walking foot or even feed option
- You are welcome to bring a finished project to work on the binding.

If your class runs through lunch time, you may want to bring a portable lunch. There is a small refrigerator available.
