**Fabric:**

Fabric Requirements

#1 – 1/2 yard	#5 – 1 1/2 yard
#2 – 3/4 yard	#6 – 1 3/4 yard
#3 – 1 yard	#7 – 2 yard
#4 – 1 1/4 yard	#8 – 3 5/8 yard—last round in quilt, 7" border & binding

\*Color sharing is the key to fabric selection. Referring to the sample, Fabric #1 (center) is used in the 9-patch with Fabric #2 and is seen in Fabric #3. The blue in Fabric #2 blends with Fabric #3 and becomes darker in #4. Green mixes with blue in Fabric #5, is solid in #6 and mixes again with blue and rose in Fabric #7. Fabric #8 (the solid rose) pulls that color from Fabric #2 as well as Fabric #7. Using simple 9-patch blocks creates a complex color palette by blending colors from the center outward.

**Pattern:** Traditions with a Twist by Blanche Young & Dalene Young Stone (Chapter 1 is excellent reading for beginners.)

**Project Supplies:**

Basic sewing kit including stiletto, seam ripper, sharp scissors

Sewing Machine with cords in good working order

Thread: 50 wt/2 ply in a neutral color e.g. muddy gray or tan

4-5 wound bobbins in a same neutral color

Schmetz Microtex Sewing Machine Needles size 60/8 or 70/10

Single Needle Throatplate if you have one

Quarter-inch sewing foot if you have one

Medium Rotary Cutter with fresh blade

Rulers: 6"x24", 6"x12", 3"x18" or 4"x14"; 8" or 12½" square

Cutting Mat: at least 12"x24"

Straight Pins: Clover Patchwork Pins Please do not bring flower head pins.

Large sheet or piece of muslin, or flannel to pin blocks & rows on for transportation.
