With just one repeated shape, create a dynamic quilt that looks stunning and complex-but it's not! This class will help guide you through the process and offer tips to make the piecing process as simple as possible. You can do it! The sample quilt is done in saturated, analogous colors for maximum impact but it can be made in the colors of your choice, even in a scrappy style.

Techniques covered:

Color theory, as applied to fabric selection

Freezer paper pattern templates

Design and pattern layout

Curved piecing

Suggestions for hand quilting, sashiko-style

Materials needed:

Assorted fabrics, minimum size 8" square scraps or more; at least 25 different patterns, depending on desired design and size of project

Sewing machine with jeans-size needle **(second class only)**

Freezer paper

Pencil

Scissors

Neutral thread

Seam ripper

Quilting pins

Marking pen with disappearing ink

Iron/ironing pad (optional)

If finishing with sashiko-style hand quilting you will also need:

Sashiko needle

Pearl cotton in color of your choice

Traditional thimble or sashiko ring-style thimble
