

Class # 521 – Zippered Boxed- Corner Purse Class

Skill level: Intermediate

Fabric prep to be completed before class.

Learn to make a zippered purse with boxed corners. Purse has an outer, zippered pocket and outer slip pocket. Purse has a zippered closure and shoulder straps. Inner purse has a slip pocket and a recessed, zippered pocket.

Supply list for finished bag size 10”long x 12”wide x 3”deep:

- Outer Pocket Fabric: ½ yard of cotton fabric
- Main Outer and Lining Fabric: 1 ¼ yard of coordinating cotton fabric
(if you use directional fabric you may need 2 yards)
- Thick Fusible Fleece Interfacing: ¾ yard (20” width) -Pellon TP 971F Fusible Thermolam Plus or equivalent
- Thin Fusible Interfacing: 2 ½ yard (20” width)-Pellon Shape Flex SF101 interfacing
- Nylon Zippers: 1-16” or longer ; 1-12” or longer; 1-10” or longer (all 1” width) coordinating colors (All zippers can be 16” or longer as we will trip excess.)
- Coordinating thread

Supplies: Rotary cutter – the 45mm size is the most useful. We have self-healing mats at the shop you may use for class. Rotary Ruler – 6” x 24”

Basic Sewing Supplies: Sewing machine in good condition with new needle; pins and/or small fabric clips; scissors; marking pencil or pen; seam gauge and/or measuring tape, fabric glue stick (not a must but helpful)

Pre-class Fabric Prep

Make the following cuts for:

The outer pockets fabric and thin interfacing-

- 9 ¼" long x 9" wide- for front and back pocket panels (cut 2 of each)
- 3" long x 10" wide-for outer zipper panels (cut 2 of each)
- 3" x 3"-for zipper tabs (2 total)

The lining fabric and the thin interfacing-

Cuts for main outer and lining fabrics and thin interfacing-

- 13" long x 13" wide-for main outer and inner purse panels (4 total)
- 9 ¼" long x 9" wide-for front and back pocket panel linings (cut 2 of fabric only-no interfacing)
- 10" x 8"-for inner recessed zipper pocket (2 of fabric and 1 of interfacing)
- 12 ½" x 13"-for inner slip pocket (1) cut interfacing 6" x 13" (1)
- 30" long x 4" wide-for shoulder straps (2-can cut longer if you prefer longer shoulder straps)
- 3" long x 10" wide -for zipper trim (2 total)

Cuts for thick interfacing only-

- 11 ½" long" x 12" wide-for main outer panels (2 total)

Following the directions on the interfacing, iron the **thin interfacing** to the **wrong side** of the above pieces as directed to cut.

Please note:


- for the outer pockets-you will only fuse the thin interfacing to the wrong side of the outer pocket fabric.
- for the recessed zipper pocket-fuse thin interfacing to the wrong side of one piece
- for the inner slip pocket-fuse the thin interfacing to the wrong side of only the top half of it (6" long x 13" wide)

-for the zipper panels-only fuse the thin interfacing to the wrong side of the outer zipper panels

Use the following directions for placement of the thick interfacing **before** ironing.

Main outer panels: place the thick interfacing so that there is approximately a ½” margin around the bottom and sides of each of the pieces. There will be approximately a 1” margin at the top of these pieces. Please note the following drawing for better understanding.

The green represents the thin interfacing on the back of the fabric. The white represents the placement of the thick interfacing.



If your class runs through lunch time, you may want to bring a portable lunch. There is a small refrigerator available.
