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Skill Level: Advanced Beginner

The Supply List and Pattern refer to the colors used in this quilt.

You are welcome to use your own colors in 2 maximum contrasting colors.

The yardage amounts are very generous for all fabrics.

Fabric:

This quilt is built entirely from scraps; yardage amounts are approximate but generous.

- 2.5 yards neutral strings for blocks, setting triangles, and borders
- 2.5 yards purple strings for blocks and borders
- 1 yard purples for background squares
- 1 yard neutrals for corner setting triangles of blocks
- 3/8 yard purple for corner setting triangles (or 2 fat quarters of same fabric)
- 4 1/3 yardage or scraps for backing
- 1/2 yard for binding (2.5" strips)

Pattern:

“Goodnight, Darlene!” is an original design by Kevin Huffman. Pattern will be distributed in class.

Project Supplies:

- Phone book pages at least 8" square (Will be supplied by teacher if you have none to bring.)
- #2 lead pencil or similar marking item
- Rotary cutter
- Ruler of your choice, however a 9.5" square ruler is helpful
- Round plate or circle template no larger than 6" in diameter

Basic Sewing Supplies:

- Working sewing machine, foot pedal, extension cord
- coordinating thread and bobbin
- pins
- scissors
- seam ripper
- iron, and small ironing mat to keep next to your sewing area

Before Class:

Strings or Strips? This quilt is built with strings. These are long pieces of fabric most deem “unusable.” There were no true sizes used as if using measured strips. If you do not have a string collection, you can make strings for this quilt by cutting from many different fabric scraps. Your strings can measure from 3/4" up to 3" wide. You will need various lengths of strings for the various blocks, but, none longer than 13". Please bring a variety of strings in all ranges of purple and all ranges of neutrals.

Also, bring many different options for the neutral setting triangles, and purple backgrounds for circle blocks.

I used ALL different backgrounds for each block.

Scrap usage and storage will also be discussed in class.

If your class runs through lunch time, you may want to bring a portable lunch. There is a small refrigerator available.
