Please have the following tools noted below.

Pattern: Twinkle Star

Recommended to have the **pattern 2 weeks prior to class and read through the instructions, cut papers and place them in the labeled bag indicated.** ***This class requires some pre class preparation. This will be provided in a separate handout.***

Working sewing machine with a quarter inch foot. Open toe foot can also be used for some of the piecing but you will need the quarter inch foot when sewing components together.

Medium Size Cutting mat 18" x 24"

Ruler: Size 6" x 24"

Add-A Quarter Ruler per instructions (12" and 18" used in this pattern per pg. 1)

Rotary Cutter with sharp blade (Judy likes to use 60mm) Cutter (I use both 45 and 60mm)

Purple Thang

Scissors

Seam Ripper

Size 70/10 needles (Microtex Sharp recommended)

Fabric glue (UHU stic) or other brand

Glue Pen (Fons and Porter, Sewline or Avery recommended)- A couple refills suggested.

High quality sewing thread (50 WT is best) (Aurifil thread is great!)

Repositional Glue Stick (made by Scotch) (Found at most Office Supply Stores)

Flower pins

Scotch Tape

Large Ziplock Bags and something to labels. (Large Gallon size bags are recommended)

Highlighter sometimes comes in handy

Binder Clips

Large Paper Clips

Medium wt. Template Plastic (to be used with Add-A-Quarter Ruler) 3” wide and length of Add-Quarter Ruler. (refer to instructions on page 2 on size of template plastic to cut)

Tweezers

Personal Iron and pressing mat

Pencil

Permanent Sharpie marker (fine to medium line is great)
