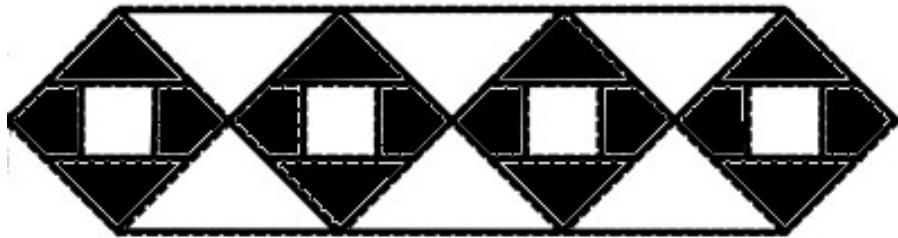


Layer Cake Leftovers



A quick table runner for your leftover layer cake squares.

Materials:

8 Layer Cakes Squares
(10 inch squares)

Assorted as follows:

1 Square - Theme/Focus print for block centers.

4 Squares -Dark prints for block corners. (Triangle A)

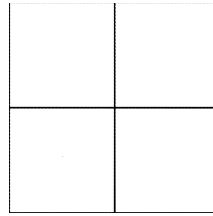
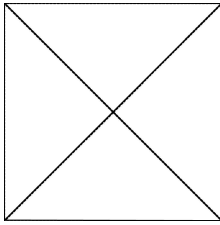
3 Squares - Medium prints for setting triangles (Triangle B)

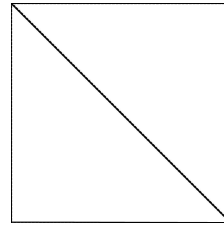
Cutting:

Cut **theme square** in half twice to get **FOUR 5"** squares



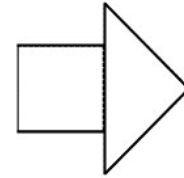
Cut **dark print squares** in half on the **diagonal twice** to get **four triangles per block** for a total of **16 Triangle A**

Cut **medium print squares** in half on the diagonal **once** to get **two triangles per square** for a total of **6 Triangle B**

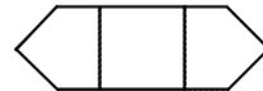


Piecing:

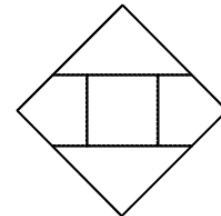
Step 1: With right sides together center the **long edge** of **triangle A** to one side of a **center square**. Sew and press seam towards square. Repeat for all squares.



Step 2: Repeat Step 1 for **opposite side** and trim triangles flush with edge of square. Repeat for all squares.

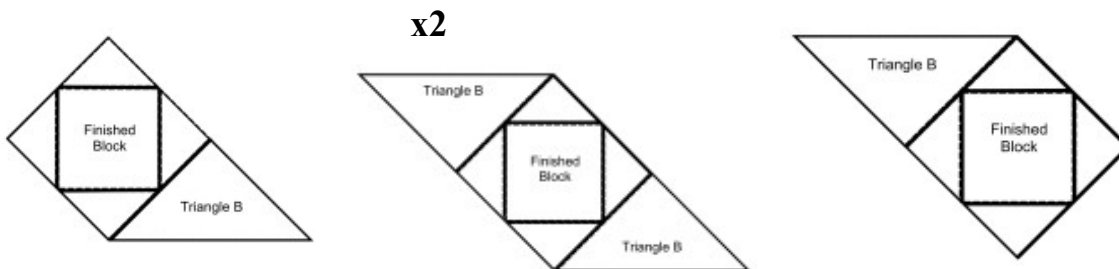


Step 3: Attach **A triangles** to remaining two sides of square. Press towards triangles. Repeat for all squares. **Square up finished block to 9 1/2"**
