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This is the first in a series of 5 classes to learn the numerous uses for the Tucker Trimmer I®. In this first class, you will learn how use it to create half square triangles and quarter square triangles. With the Tucker Trimmer I® alone, a quilter can make these units in 11 different finished sizes, ranging from 1" to 6". In class we will be making 4" finished units.

These units are basic units, therefore they must be precise to fit nicely with more advanced units. This is a perfect place for any quilter to begin their journey through the Studio 180 Design set of tools.

In future classes you will learn how to expand the use of your Tucker Trimmer I®. Many interesting units can be made with this one simple tool.

There are 2 other Tucker Trimmers. The Tucker Trimmer II is used to make another 11 different finished sizes from 3/4" to 5-3/4". For bigger units the Tucker Trimmer III allows you to make 24 different finished sizes from 1" to 12-1/2". This tool is also useful for squaring up larger blocks.

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing machine with power cords and manual

Thread

Machine needles

Snips or trimming scissors

Seam ripper

Fabric Requirements

Fabrics may be cut during class but precutting will allow more time for sewing. You may want to use the same fabric for all 5 Tucker Trimmer classes so keep that in mind when selecting fabric. If so, I recommend a focal fabric, a background and at least 2 coordinating fabrics.

Focal Fabric, cut

2 (two) 5" x 5" squares.

1 (one) 5-1/2" x 5-1/2"

square.

1 (one) 10" x 10" square

Background Fabric, cut

1 (one) 5" x 5" square.

2 (two) 5-1/2" x 5-1/2"

squares.

1 (one) 10" x 10" square.

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a shar blade

Marking pencil

Small cutting mat

Straight edge ruler approx.. 6" x 12" or so

Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Coordinating Fabric(s), cut

1 (one) 5" x 5" square.

1 (one) 5-1/2" x 5-1/2"

square.
