Baby Book Construction

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

In this hands-on class, you will learn the full process of constructing a soft fabric baby book from start to finish. You will begin by selecting a book panel, available for purchase at the shop, then learn how to properly cut out each page, square blocks accurately, and prepare them for assembly. Instruction will cover safe and accurate use of a rotary cutter and ruler, working with fusible fleece, edge stitching, and sewing through multiple layers of fabric and fleece. By the end of class, you will understand the complete construction process so you can confidently make additional fabric books on your own.

YOUR SUPPLY LIST (WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING):

- your personal machine
- 80/20 universal machine needles
- rotary cutter
- glass head pins
- white 100% polyester thread
- quilting ruler
- fabric scissors and/or snips
- seam ripper
