## WHAT YOU WILL LEARN:

You will learn how to cut, size and interface each tee shirt. Then you will need to decide the layout of your quilt. You will learn how to do sashing between each shirt. The last things you will learn is to add borders to your quilt and make the backing for it. Please bring all clean tee shirts that you think you want in your quilt. You can bring your own fabric or purchase from a wonderful selection at Berger's once you get your tee shirts cut. **PLEASE DO NOT CUT YOUR TEE SHIRTS BY YOURSELF!** 

## YOUR SUPPLY LIST (WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING):

- 4-5 yds Interfacing Pellon SF 101\*
- 1 ½ yds of fabric that will be used for sashing between the squares\*
- Border, backing and binding fabric will depend on how big your quilt will be\*
- Sewing machine in GOOD working order\*
- 1/4" pressure foot
- Non-stick pressing sheet I like "The Appliqué Pressing Sheet"
- Cotton thread that matches your fabric or neutral thread\*
- Rotary cutter with new blade\*
- Cutting mat\*
- 6" x 22" ruler
- Square rulers, at least 12" x 12"
- Notebook and pencil
- New needles\*
- Fabric marking pens\*
- Long pins and/or Wonder Clips\*
- Seam gauges and tape measures\*
- Sharp scissors\*
- Any other sewing notion you usually use (like glasses and seam rippers\*)
